Mr. FOGARTY, from the Committee on Appropriations, reported the following joint resolution; which was committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the Union and ordered to be printed

JOINT RESOLUTION

Making supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1964, for certain activities of the Department of Health, Education, and Welfare related to mental retardation, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
- 2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated, out of any money
- 4 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the fiscal
- 5 year ending June 30, 1964, namely:

1 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND
2 WELFARE

3 OFFICE OF EDUCATION

4 EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT FOR THE HANDICAPPED

5 For grants for training and research and demonstrations
6 with respect to handicapped children pursuant to the Act of
7 September 6, 1958, as amended (20 U.S.C. 611-617), and
8 section 302 of the Mental Retardation Facilities and Com-
9 munity Mental Health Centers Construction Act of 1963
10 (Public Law 88-164), and for salaries and expenses in con-
11 nection therewith, \$11,685,000, of which not to exceed
12 \$185,000 shall be for such salaries and expenses, including
13 services as authorized by section 15 of the Act of August
14 2, 1946 (5 U.S.C. 55a): *Provided*, That the unexpended
15 balances of the funds appropriated for "Expansion of teaching
16 in education of the mentally retarded" and "Expansion of
17 teaching in education of the deaf" in the Department of
18 Health, Education, and Welfare Appropriation Act, 1964,
19 shall be merged with this appropriation.

20 PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE

21 CHRONIC DISEASES AND HEALTH OF THE AGED

22 For an additional amount for "Chronic diseases and
23 health of the aged", \$2,277,000, of which \$2,200,000 shall
24 be available for grants under title XVII of the Social Secu-

1 rity Act for planning comprehensive action to combat mental
2 retardation.

3 HOSPITAL CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

4 For an additional amount for "Hospital construction
5 activities", \$5,049,000, of which \$5,000,000 shall be avail-
6 able until expended for grants under part B of the Mental
7 Retardation Facilities Construction Act (Public Law
8 88-164).

9 GRANTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF HEALTH RESEARCH

10 FACILITIES

11 For an additional amount for "Grants for construction
12 of health research facilities", \$6,000,000, to be available for
13 grants under part D of title VII of the Public Health
14 Service Act.

15 SOCIAL SECURITY ADMINISTRATION

16 GRANTS FOR MATERNAL AND CHILD WELFARE

17 For an additional amount for "Grants for maternal and
18 child welfare", \$16,500,000, of which \$5,000,000 shall be
19 available for maternal and child health services, \$5,000,000
20 for services for crippled children, \$5,000,000 for special
21 project grants for maternity and infant care pursuant to
22 section 531 of the Social Security Act, and \$1,500,000 for
23 research projects relating to maternal and child health and
24 crippled children's services: *Provided*, That \$1,250,000 of

1 the additional amount appropriated herein for maternal and
 2 child health services which is available under section 502 (b)
 3 of the Social Security Act shall be used only for special
 4 projects for mentally retarded children, and \$1,250,000 of
 5 the additional amount appropriated herein for services for
 6 crippled children which is available under section 512 (b)
 7 of such Act, shall be used only for special projects for serv-
 8 ices for crippled children who are mentally retarded.

9 **SALARIES AND EXPENSES, CHILDREN'S BUREAU**

10 For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses,
 11 Children's Bureau", \$375,000.

12 **GENERAL PROVISION**

13 Funds for salaries and expenses included in the foregoing
 14 paragraphs may be transferred between the appropriations
 15 contained herein.
