Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Education and Labor

A BILL

To amend title II of the National Defense Education Act of 1958 to provide for forgiveness of loans made under that title to students who subsequently engage in the practice of medicine, dentistry, or osteopathy in areas having a shortage of individuals engaged in such practice.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) paragraph (3) of subsection (b) of section 205
4 of the National Defense Education Act of 1958 (20 U.S.C.
5 425) is amended by inserting immediately after "(3)" the
6 following: "(A) any such loan (plus interest) shall be
7 canceled for practice of medicine, dentistry, or osteopathy
8 by the recipient within an area in a State determined by

1 that State's health authority to have a shortage of individuals
2 engaged in such practice at the rate of 25 per centum of the
3 amount of such loan plus interest thereon, which was unpaid
4 on the first day of such practice or July 1, 1963, whichever
5 date occurs last, for each complete year of such practice,
6 or (B)".

7 (b) Paragraph (2) of such subsection (b) is amended—

8 (1) by striking out "or (iii)" and inserting in lieu
9 thereof "(iii)"; and

10 (2) by inserting immediately before "(B)" the
11 following: ", or (iv) during which the borrower is serv-
12 ing as a full-time intern or resident in a hospital in a
13 State, except that this clause (iv) shall apply to any loan
14 outstanding on the effective date of this clause (iv)
15 only with the consent of the then obligee institution,".

16 SEC. 2. The amendments made by this Act shall take
17 effect on the first day of the calendar month next succeeding
18 the month in which this Act is enacted, but the amendment
19 made by subsection (a) of the first section shall not give
20 any person any right to recover any amount repaid prior
21 to such date on any loan made under title II of the National
22 Defense Education Act of 1958.
