Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works

A BILL

Authorizing the Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority to impose tolls for the use of the bridge across Mount Hope Bay between the towns of Bristol and Portsmouth, in Rhode Island.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
 3 That the Act entitled "An Act granting the consent of Con-
 4 gress to the Mount Hope Bridge Company, its successors and
 5 assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge across
 6 Mount Hope Bay between the towns of Bristol and Ports-
 7 mouth, in Rhode Island", approved March 3, 1927 (44 Stat.
 8 1391), is amended by striking out section 3 and inserting in
 9 lieu thereof the following:

1 “SEC. 3. That upon title to the bridge which was con-
 2 structed under the authority of this Act becoming vested in
 3 the Rhode Island Turnpike and Bridge Authority, created
 4 by chapter 3390, Public Laws of Rhode Island, 1954 (chap-
 5 ter 12 of title 24, General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956),
 6 upon the terms and conditions provided for in said chapter
 7 12, as heretofore amended, said authority shall be author-
 8 ized to fix, charge, and collect tolls for the use of said bridge
 9 and to apply the same in accordance with the provisions of
 10 said chapter 12, as heretofore amended, and to combine said
 11 bridge for financing purposes with any other bridge financed
 12 by said authority under the provisions of said chapter 12, as
 13 heretofore amended.”
