Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Public Works

A BILL

Authorizing the State of Rhode Island or its instrumentality to maintain, repair, and operate the bridge across Mount Hope Bay subject to the terms and conditions of the Act approved March 23, 1906.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the Act entitled "An Act granting the consent of
4 Congress to the Mount Hope Bridge Company, its successors
5 and assigns, to construct, maintain, and operate a bridge
6 across Mount Hope Bay between the towns of Bristol and
7 Portsmouth, in Rhode Island", approved March 3, 1927
8 (44 Stat. 1391), is amended by striking out section 3 and
9 inserting in lieu thereof the following new section:

1 "SEC. 3. If and when title to such bridge shall become
 2 vested in the State of Rhode Island or the Rhode Island
 3 Turnpike and Bridge Authority, an instrumentality of said
 4 State, the maintenance, repair, and operation of such bridge
 5 shall thereafter be governed by the laws of the State of
 6 Rhode Island applicable to such bridge, subject, however, to
 7 the terms and conditions of the Act entitled 'An Act to
 8 regulate the construction of bridges over navigable waters,'
 9 approved March 23, 1906."
