Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend paragraph 1537 (b) of the Tariff Act of 1930 with respect to certain footwear.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled. 3 That paragraph 1537 (b) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as 4 amended (19 U.S.C. sec. 1001, par. 1537 (b)), is amended 5 by adding at the end thereof the following new sentence: 6 "For the purposes of any existing proclamation made pur-7 suant to section 336 which applied to certain footwear classi-8 fiable under this subparagraph (and for the purposes of any 9 proclamation heretofore or hereafter made to the extent that 10 it relates to such existing proclamation), the footwear provided for in this subparagraph to which such existing procla-11

mation applies shall be deemed to be hunting boots, galoshes, 1 2 rainwear, and other footwear designed to be worn over, or 3 in lieu of, other footwear as a protection against water, oil, grease, or chemicals, or cold or inclement weather, all the 4 5 foregoing wholly or in chief value of natural rubber, synthetic rubber, or plastics, or of combinations thereof (and for 6 7 such purposes shall not include footwear with uppers of nonmolded construction formed by sewing the parts thereof 8 9 together and having exposed on the outer surface a substantial portion of functional stitching)." 10

SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of this
Act shall apply to articles entered or withdrawn from warehouse for consumption on or after the 90th day after the date
of the enactment of this Act.
