Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Ways and Means

A BILL

To amend paragraph 1537 (b) of the Tariff Act of 1930 with respect to certain footwear.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That paragraph 1537 (b) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as
4 amended (19 U.S.C. sec. 1001, par. 1537 (b)), is amended
5 by adding at the end thereof the following new sentence:
6 “For the purposes of any existing proclamation made pur-
7 suant to section 336 which applied to certain footwear classi-
8 fiable under this subparagraph (and for the purposes of any
9 proclamation heretofore or hereafter made to the extent that
10 it relates to such existing proclamation), the footwear pro-
11 vided for in this subparagraph to which such existing procla-

1 mation applies shall be deemed to be hunting boots, galoshes,
2 rainwear, and other footwear designed to be worn over, or
3 in lieu of, other footwear as a protection against water, oil,
4 grease, or chemicals, or cold or inclement weather, all the
5 foregoing wholly or in chief value of natural rubber, syn-
6 thetic rubber, or plastics, or of combinations thereof (and for
7 such purposes shall not include footwear with uppers of
8 nonmolded construction formed by sewing the parts thereof
9 together and having exposed on the outer surface a sub-
10 stantial portion of functional stitching).”

11 SEC. 2. The amendment made by the first section of this
12 Act shall apply to articles entered or withdrawn from ware-
13 house for consumption on or after the 90th day after the date
14 of the enactment of this Act.
