- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 That section 203 (a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act
- 4 (8 U.S.C. 1153 (a); 66 Stat. 178) is amended by adding
- 5 at the end thereof an additional paragraph (5) reading as
- 6 follows:
- 7 "(5) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this sec-
- 8 tion, any immigrant unmarried son or daughter under the age
- 9 of fourteen years, of an immigrant parent eligible for a pref-
- 10 erence under this section, who is accompanying such parent
- 11 to the United States, shall be granted the same preference
- 12 status in the quota as the parent."
