## A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act.

1     *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That section 203 (a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act  
4 (8 U.S.C. 1153 (a) ; 66 Stat. 178) is amended by adding  
5 at the end thereof an additional paragraph (5) reading as  
6 follows:

7     “(5) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this sec-  
8 tion, any immigrant unmarried son or daughter under the age  
9 of fourteen years, of an immigrant parent eligible for a pref-  
10 erence under this section, who is accompanying such parent  
11 to the United States, shall be granted the same preference  
12 status in the quota as the parent.”
