## IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES

Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Interstate and Foreign Commerce

---

## A BILL

To extend and expand title III of the Mental Retardation Facilities and Community Mental Health Centers Construction Act of 1963 (Public Law 88-164).

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3 That section 1 of the Act of September 6, 1958 (Public Law  
4 85-926), as amended by section 301 of Public Law 88-164,  
5 is further amended by striking out the word "and" after  
6 "such personnel" in the third sentence and inserting in lieu  
7 thereof a comma, and by striking out the period at the end of  
8 the sentence and inserting in lieu thereof "and for construct-  
9 ing, modifying, furnishing, operating, and maintaining student

1 teaching or training facilities to assist in the training of pro-  
2 fessional personnel.”

3 SEC. 2. In the first sentence in section 2 strike out the  
4 word “or” after “handicapped children” and insert in lieu  
5 thereof a comma. Such sentence is further amended by  
6 striking out the period at the end and inserting in lieu thereof  
7 “or as speech correctionists, or other specialists providing  
8 special services for education of such children, or engaged or  
9 preparing to engage in research in fields related to education  
10 of such children.”

11 SEC. 3. The second sentence of section 2 is amended by  
12 striking out the word “such” after the words “to assist” and  
13 inserting in lieu thereof “the States and”. Section 2 is  
14 further amended by adding a sentence: “Grants may also  
15 be made available to construct, modify, furnish, operate,  
16 and maintain student teaching or training facilities to assist  
17 in the training of professional personnel, and for the support  
18 of professional personnel or other specialists responsible for  
19 the administration or supervision of special education pro-  
20 grams at the State and local levels.”

21 SEC. 4. Section 5 is amended by adding at the end  
22 thereof the following new paragraph:

23 “(c) The term ‘State’ includes the Commonwealth of  
24 Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, the District of Columbia,  
25 Guam, and American Samoa.”

1        SEC. 5. Section 7 of Public Law 85-926 as amended by  
2 section 301 of Public Law 88-164 is further amended to read  
3 as follows:

4        "SEC. 7. There are authorized to be appropriated for  
5 carrying out this Act \$40,000,000 for the fiscal year ending  
6 June 30, 1966; \$60,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June  
7 30, 1967; \$70,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30,  
8 1968; \$80,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969;  
9 \$90,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1970. Sums  
10 appropriated under this Act for any fiscal year shall remain  
11 available for making grants in the next succeeding fiscal  
12 year."

13        SEC. 6. Part (a) of section 302 of Public Law 88-164  
14 is amended to read as follows:

15        "SEC. 302. (a) There are authorized to be appropriated  
16 \$6,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966; \$12,-  
17 000,000 for fiscal year ending June 30, 1967; \$18,000,000  
18 for fiscal year ending June 30, 1968; \$25,000,000 for fiscal  
19 year ending June 30, 1969; and \$30,000,000 for fiscal year  
20 ending June 30, 1970, to enable the Commissioner of Educa-  
21 tion to make grants to States, State or local educational agen-  
22 cies, public and nonprofit private institutions of higher learn-  
23 ing, and other public or nonprofit private educational or  
24 research agencies and organizations for research or demon-  
25 stration projects and for constructing and equipping research

1 facilities by institutions of higher learning to carry out such  
2 projects relating to education for mentally retarded, hard of  
3 hearing, deaf, speech impaired, visually handicapped, seri-  
4 ously emotionally disturbed, crippled, or other health im-  
5 paired children who by reason thereof require special  
6 education (hereinafter in this section referred to as 'handi-  
7 capped children'). Such grants shall be made in installments,  
8 in advance or by way of reimbursement, and on such condi-  
9 tions as the Commissioner of Education may determine.  
10 Sums appropriated under this Act for any fiscal year shall  
11 remain available for making grants in the next succeeding  
12 fiscal year."
