Mr. FOGARTY introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To amend the Immigration and Nationality Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That section 212 of the Immigration and Nationality Act
4 (8 U.S.C. 1182) be amended by changing the designation
5 of subsection (i) (inadvertently designated "(f)" by section
6 109 (c) of the Act of September 21, 1961) to read "(j)",
7 and by adding a new subsection (i) to read as follows:
8 " (i) Any alien who is excludable from the United
9 States under paragraph (1) or (4) of subsection (a) of this
10 section on account of mental retardation shall, if otherwise
11 admissible, be issued a visa and admitted to the United States

1 for permanent residence in accordance with such terms, con-
2 ditions, and controls, if any, including the giving of a bond,
3 as the Attorney General, in his discretion after consultation
4 with the Surgeon General of the United States Public Health
5 Service, may by regulations prescribe.”
