Mr. FOGARTY, from the Committee on Appropriations, reported the following bill; which was committed to the Committee of the Whole House on the State of the Union and ordered to be printed

A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the Departments of Labor, and Health, Education, and Welfare for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966, and for other purposes.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following sums are appropriated out of any money
4 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to supply sup-
5 plemental appropriations for the Departments of Labor, and
6 Health, Education, and Welfare (this Act may be cited as

1 the "Departments of Labor, and Health, Education, and Wel-
2 fare Supplemental Appropriation Act, 1966") for the fiscal
3 year ending June 30, 1966, and for other purposes, namely:

4 CHAPTER I

5 DEPARTMENT OF LABOR

6 MANPOWER ADMINISTRATION

7 MANPOWER DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING ACTIVITIES

8 For an additional amount for "Manpower development
9 and training activities", \$126,070,000.

10 OFFICE OF MANPOWER ADMINISTRATOR, SALARIES AND

11 EXPENSES

12 For an additional amount for "Office of Manpower Ad-
13 ministrator, salaries and expenses", \$27,535,800.

14 BUREAU OF APPRENTICESHIP AND TRAINING, SALARIES

15 AND EXPENSES

16 For an additional amount for "Bureau of Apprentice-
17 ship and Training, salaries and expenses", \$353,000.

1 BUREAU OF EMPLOYMENT SECURITY, SALARIES AND
2 EXPENSES

3 For an additional amount for "Bureau of Employment
4 Security, salaries and expenses", \$844,200.

5 OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY

6 SALARIES AND EXPENSES, ACTIVITIES RELATING TO AD-
7 MISSION AND EMPLOYMENT IN AGRICULTURE OF
8 NONIMMIGRANT ALIENS

9 For expenses necessary for the performance of such func-
10 tions as the Secretary of Labor deems necessary to assure,
11 in connection with the admission of nonimmigrant aliens
12 under the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
13 1184) for employment in agriculture, that maximum efforts
14 are made to recruit and retain agricultural workers for avail-
15 able job opportunities, that domestic workers are given
16 preference in employment over alien workers, and that
17 the employment of alien workers does not adversely affect
18 the wages and working conditions of workers in this country,
19 \$1,723,000.

CHAPTER II

DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH, EDUCATION, AND
WELFARE

OFFICE OF EDUCATION

ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES

For grants and payments under title II of the Act of September 30, 1950, as amended by title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, and under titles II, III, and V of said 1965 Act, \$967,000,000, of which \$775,000,000 shall be for meeting the special educational needs of educationally deprived children under title II of the Act of September 30, 1950, as amended: *Provided*, That determinations and payments under such title shall be on the basis of the amount authorized to be appropriated for such title, \$100,000,000 shall be for school library resources, textbooks, and other instructional materials under title II of said Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, \$75,000,000 shall be for supplementary educational centers and services under title III of said Act, and \$17,000,000 shall be for strengthening State departments of education under title V of said Act.

RESEARCH AND TRAINING

For research, surveys, training, dissemination of information, and demonstrations in education as authorized by the

1 Act of July 26, 1954 (20 U.S.C. 331-332), as amended
2 by title IV of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act
3 of 1965, \$45,000,000, of which not to exceed \$20,000,000
4 shall remain available until expended for construction of
5 regional facilities for research and related purposes under sec-
6 tion 4 of such Act: *Provided*, That funds appropriated in the
7 Department of Health, Education, and Welfare Appropria-
8 tion Act, 1966, under the heading "Cooperative research",
9 shall be transferred to and merged with this appropriation.

10 SALARIES AND EXPENSES

11 For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses",
12 \$4,050,000.

13 VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION ADMINISTRATION

14 RESEARCH AND TRAINING

15 For an additional amount for "Research and training",
16 \$6,100,000.

17 SALARIES AND EXPENSES

18 For an additional amount for "Salaries and expenses",
19 \$70,000.

20 PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICE

21 CHRONIC DISEASES AND HEALTH OF THE AGED

22 For an additional amount for "Chronic diseases and
23 health of the aged", \$12,800,000.

1 COMMUNICABLE DISEASE ACTIVITIES

2 For an additional amount for "Communicable disease
3 activities", \$1,000,000.

4 COMMUNITY HEALTH PRACTICE AND RESEARCH

5 For an additional amount for "Community health prac-
6 tice and research", \$2,700,000.

7 NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF GENERAL MEDICAL SCIENCES

8 For an additional amount for "National Institute of
9 General Medical Sciences", \$2,200,000.

10 NATIONAL CANCER INSTITUTE

11 For an additional amount for "National Cancer Insti-
12 tute", \$4,000,000.

13 NATIONAL HEART INSTITUTE

14 For an additional amount for "National Heart Institute",
15 \$9,800,000.

16 NATIONAL INSTITUTE OF NEUROLOGICAL DISEASES AND
17 BLINDNESS

18 For an additional amount for "National Institute of
19 Neurological Diseases and Blindness", \$4,250,000.

20 ADMINISTRATION ON AGING

21 For grants for community planning, services, and train-
22 ing, and for grants and contracts for research and develop-
23 ment projects and training projects, and for consultative

1 services, technical assistance, training and other services,
2 relating to programs for the aged and aging, and for salaries
3 and expenses in connection therewith, \$7,000,000, as author-
4 ized by the Older Americans Act of 1965: *Provided*, That
5 upon establishment of the Administration on Aging, any
6 funds appropriated in the Department of Health, Education,
7 and Welfare Appropriation Act, 1966, under the head
8 "Salaries and expenses, Office of Aging" shall be transferred
9 to and merged with this appropriation.

10 **OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY**

11 **OFFICE OF AUDIT, SALARIES AND EXPENSES**

12 For an additional amount for "Office of Audit, salaries
13 and expenses", \$180,000.

14 **OFFICE OF THE GENERAL COUNSEL, SALARIES AND**

15 **EXPENSES**

16 For an additional amount for "Office of the General
17 Counsel, salaries and expenses", \$85,500.

18 **NATIONAL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE FOR THE DEAF**

19 For carrying out the National Technical Institute for
20 the Deaf Act (Public Law 89-36), \$420,000, to remain
21 available until expended.
