A BILL

Making supplemental appropriations for the Departments of Labor, and Health, Education, and Welfare for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 That the following sums are appropriated out of any money
- 4 in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to supply sup-
- 5 plemental appropriations for the Departments of Labor, and
- 6 Health, Education, and Welfare (this Act may be cited as

13	1184) for employment in agriculture, that maximum efforts
14	are made to recruit and retain agricultural workers for avail-
15	able job opportunities, that domestic workers are given
16	preference in employment over alien workers, and that
L7	the employment of alien workers does not adversely affect
18	the wages and working conditions of workers in this country,
19	\$1,723,000.
