Congressman John E. Fogarty today announced that funds have been approved authorizing surveys to be made of Pawtuxet Cove in Cranston and Warwick; Little Narragansett Bay and Watch Hill in Westerly; and the Harbor of Refuge and Point Judith Pond at Point Judith. Such funds have been authorized in the Public Works Appropriation Bill for 1958 which has now passed both the House and Senate branches of Congress. Mr. Fogarty, who is a ranking member of the House Appropriations Committee, stated that the surveys will be made for the purpose of determining the feasibility of improving the existing projects at this time. Each of the proposed projects was originally sponsored by Congressman Fogarty and through his efforts authorization of the Public Works Committee was secured. The specific amounts appropriated and purposes of each project are listed on the attached sheet.
