Congressman John E. Fogarty today made a statement in strong praise of the research fellowship named in honor of Major John T. Godfrey. Major Godfrey, a prominent citizen of Rhode Island, is a victim of amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, a disease for which no cure is known. The National Neurological Research Foundation, 3255 N Street, Washington, D.C. is conducting a drive locally, and on a national scale, to raise funds for the Major John T. Godfrey Fellowship. Congressman Fogarty strongly urged all citizens of Rhode Island to contribute if possible and in any case to support the campaign. He pointed out that only through research can cures be found for the neurological diseases, most of which are incurable.
