"Report to the Nation"
on
Ten Years of Progress in
Arthritis and Metabolic Diseases

It has been with great personal pride that I have listened to the reports of progress given here this afternoon. As Chairman of the subcommittee on appropriations all through the life of this Institute, I have watched with particular interest the growth of its many activities.

I have become acutely aware of the problems which face us in the Institute's many areas of responsibility.

Some of the speakers on the program have appeared before me on numerous occasions, and reported on the situation in their respective fields.
