North Attleboro Lieutenant to Hunter Field

NORTH ATTLEBORO—Second Lt. Donald C. Schriever of this town has reported for duty at Hunter field, it was announced recently by Col. Bernard T. Castor, Commanding Officer, Hunter Field, Ga.

Lt. Schriever attained the rating of staff sergeant before going to Officer Candidate school at Miami Beach, Fla. in May 1943. Completing his course of training at the Army Air Forces Statistical school at Harvard University, he was commissioned a second lieutenant in the Air Corps at Boston in August 1943. Assigned to an airdrome squadron at Hunter field he performs the duties of a statistical officer.

A native of this town, he attended grammar and high schools here and was graduated from Providence college, Providence, in 1935. He also studied at Boston University for one year, while working for the Gulf Oil corp. as a merchandising salesman.
