

MEETING WITH FATHER MAXWELL

Aug. 17, 1943--B.A. McLaughlin, O.P.

THE ESSENTIAL POINTS IN THIS MEETING WERE:

1. Father Maxwell:

" I have not signed any contract with the Navy;
I have signed only a temporary agreement.
I am getting \$20 per man taught."

2. Father Maxwell:

" It is the bunk that the War Department will not
pay salaries to religious.
Our Father Rooney found out this was so from
the War Department in Washington."

3. Father Maxwell:

" I intend to wait and to see how Father Gannon
of Fordham makes out in his contract, then,
I will follow him because I want to follow one
who has been successful".
