

Providence College is now operating on a trimester basis and the starting dates of these trimesters are as follows: Spring Term, January 5, 1944; Summer Term, April 19, 1944; Fall Term, September 19, 1944. Classes are held six days a week, Monday through Friday from 8:00 A. M. to 5:00 P. M. and Saturdays from 8:00 A. M. to 12:00 Noon.

The instruction will be classroom and laboratory instruction regularly given to the students of the College in the established courses of study in the following fields: Art, Astronomy, Biology, Business Administration, Chemistry, Drawing, Economics, Education, English, French, German, History, Italian, Latin, Greek, Mathematics, Mechanics, Music, Philosophy, Physics, Political Science, Psychology, Public Speaking, Religion, Sociology, Spanish and Surveying.

The Degrees granted in courses by Providence College are Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Philosophy, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

All Degrees are awarded in the name of Providence College and the requirements for these Degrees are listed in the catalog of the College, which catalog is hereby adopted and made part of this contract. The charge per student, per trimester will be \$195.00 and includes tuition, use of books, supplies and equipment.

(Note: This charge has been adjusted to cover certain items such as books, and supplies which our students ordinarily provide for themselves.)
