1. It should be noted that the Army Specialized Training Program consists of the following parts:
 1. Scholastic
 2. Military
 3. Physical
 4. Medical

2. In reference to this military program the following facts should be noted:
 1. The 4 parts are considered by the War Department as ONE whole; not any part more important than the other.
 2. Persons serving in any department are under contract with War Department.

3. In reference to Doctor O'Reilly I wish to submit the following:
 1. He has been with the department since July 12, 1943, the day the Army trainees came to the College.
 2. He carries the major load in the department.

He must be at the College 6 days a week at 7:15 in the morning, and once a month at 6:15.

He is subject to call by Major Smith, the Commandant, at all times.
 3. He is now thoroughly with the workings of the medical department having been on the job from the beginning.

4. In trying to get a replacement for Dr. Burns some time ago, the College after careful investigation was forced to accept another Doctor who is 4F.

In the light of these facts, the College requests the retention of Dr. O'Reilly in the Medical Department of the Army Specialized Program.
