

I Rules for picking schools draw up by Mc Nutt in consultation with Army  
+ Navy Secretaries.

2. Actual selection of schools by a joint committee of armed  
services + War Man Power Com - but in  
event of disagreement Mc Nutt will have final  
word.

3. In formulating plan those involved are:

- ① Educators
- ② Staff of the War Manpower Commission in particular.
- ③ A committee of the Amer. Council of Education
- ④ Navy Advisory Council on Education

4. Army will send men to College from:

- ① The ranks
- ② Present college men enrolled in Enlisted Reserve units

Navy will send:

- ① Men enlisted in its Enlisted Reserves
- ② Qualified applicants from civilian life

5. Army will follow not only <sup>general</sup> methods of choosing men for officers  
candidate schools, but will use also such additional  
methods of ascertaining qualifications as may be deemed  
appropriate after consulting with the American  
Council on Education.

6. The curricula will be prepared in consultation with the American  
Council on Education



7. Pre-medical will be allowed in college until end of 1st full 1943 semester ~~year~~.

8. Present Naval R.O.J.C units at colleges will be continued
