COLLEGES TO BE ASSIGNED TRAINING

- 1. Official plan states that colleges will be selected by the War Department after consultation with the American Council on Education. Also requests no college to make inquiry.
- 2. Unofficial estimates say that some 350 colleges will be involved.
- 3. 350 is about one third of those now in the ERC program.
- 4. One third of ERC colleges in New England is about 25.
- 5. Certain colleges have already received questionnaires from the National Register of Scientists, which stated they were for use of the Army and Navy. The questionnaires asked detailed facts on housing facilities, messing facilities, laboratories, teaching staff, recitation halls, etc., and was to be submitted immediately.
- 5. The Secretary of the Navy has stated that the Navy will favor small colleges which have not large endowments and which are not state-supported.
