Since Father English has definite information that the Government has drawn up the list of colleges to which students are to be sent I believe the following steps should be taken, for if Father English is right there is no need for us to proceed on our present course:

1. I will call Col Beukema in Washington on the telephone and tell him that you (Fr. Dillon) received a phone call from Washington last night and it has disturbed you. Father Dillon has a question that he would like to ask Col. Beukema.
