

He first I wen killed in action, were 2 boys from Provderce College - Ray Conley and Paul It happened like this, all the DIs from I roudence were put in the 378 th Regiment of the J6 " Yarkee Divoiar, He 3 78 TH was fished to be the first from the Division to be committed to combot, We went on the front live the evening of Oct 5, 1944, in a sector rear Porta transon travece, We relieved elements of the forth bursion, Confranz by company taking ova their fortiles, I went a foxfole. It was a relatively quiet sector but lucry over in awfile, the Germans would throw over 6-10 artilley stells, as would the US

artilley. Her it would be quiet for a long fell. Auring one of these certillary barrages the right of Oct 7, a Keman stell landed in the forfold where Corley and Toley were and kelled them instantly, as I said they were the first I KIA in the whole Dursian of 15,000 men, you way know of this story abready.
