Muddy fields, frigid temperatures, sleepless nights, lonely hours, fright, fear, and hunger--memories and thoughts tucked away for 66 years. On December 16th, 1944, the vanguard of three German Armies, totaling 500,000 men, attacked us in the Ardennes region of Belgium and Luxembourg, achieving total surprise. This was the bloodiest battle of World War 2 and after six weeks, the enemy was driven back to where they started. We shall always remember the 19,000 who made the supreme sacrifice.
