**Very Reverend Kenneth Cyprian Sullivan, O.P.**

Father Kenneth C. Sullivan is Prior-Provincial of the Dominican Fathers of the Province of St. Joseph. For more than a quarter of a century he has enjoyed a distinguished career in ecclesiastical positions in Newark, New Jersey, Providence, Rhode Island, Cincinnati, Ohio and New York City. A graduate of Providence College, Father Sullivan successfully completed studies for his advanced degrees in theology in Washington, D.C. in 1936. Father Sullivan is a native of East St. Louis, Illinois, and was born on August 1, 1910.

**Robert Hale Ives Goddard, Jr.**

Robert H.I. Goddard, Jr., received the degree of Bachelor of Arts from Yale in 1932 and was graduated from the Harvard School of Business Administration in 1934. Besides his present position as Trustee of Brown & Ives, Mr. Goddard serves as a member of the Board of Directors of several Rhode Island industries. Noted for his dedicated interest in Community affairs, he has served as Chairman and President of the United Fund, and is currently President of the Greater YMCA, the Providence Athenaeum and the Federated Arts Fund. Mr. Goddard was born in Providence on December 9, 1909, and serves on the President's Advisory Council of Providence College.

**John Tucker Hayward**

Vice admiral John T. Hayward was born in New York City on November 15, 1910. He received his Bachelor of Science degree from the United States Naval Academy in 1930. Prior to his appointment as President of the Naval War College in Newport in January, 1966, Admiral Hayward experienced an extensive and varied military career as Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Development, Strike Force Commander in the Cuban Operation, and Commander of the United States Anti-submarine Forces in the entire Pacific. He has been decorated by the British, Italian and French Governments. He was the first military man to receive the Robert D. Conrad Scientific Award.

**Stephan George Kuttner**

Stephan George Kuttner was born in Germany on March 24, 1907. Dr. Kuttner matriculated at the Universities of Frankfurt and Freiburg. He holds his Doctorate of Civil and Canon Law from the University of Berlin. In 1933 he emigrated to Italy to serve as a Research Associate in the Vatican Library and as Associate Professor at the Lateran University in Rome. He presently serves as editor of "Monumenta juris canonici". His distinguished awards include the Guggenheim Fellowship Award and the Prize for Distinguished Contribution to Humanities, American Council of Learned Societies. A member of various learned societies and a noted author, Dr. Kuttner is currently the T. Lawrason Riggs Professor of Religious Studies at Yale University.

**Harry Read Seelen**

A native of Staten Island, New York, Harry Read Seelen was born on September 27, 1907. He was graduated from Providence College in 1929 and pursued graduate studies at Northwestern Graduate School of Business, Newark College of Engineering and Rutgers University. Mr. Seelen is a co-author of articles in the field of electrical engineering. He is an active member in many civic, religious and public welfare organizations. Mr. Seelen was elected a Fellow of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers in 1965 and is one of the recipients of the RCA Victor Award of Merit. Mr. Seelen is a Divisional Vice President of the Radio Corporation of America.

**Reverend Theodore M. Hesburgh, C.S.C.**

Father Theodore M. Hesburgh, C.S.C. comes from Syracuse, New York. He was born in that city on May 25, 1917. Having completed his undergraduate studies at the Gregorian University in Rome, he pursued doctoral studies in theology at the Catholic University of America from 1943 to 1945. After serving in various teaching and administrative positions, Father Hesburgh was elected President of the University of Notre Dame in 1952. He serves as a member of the Board of Directors and of committees of twenty-eight different academic, civic and religious organizations.
