GENO BARONI

A native of Acosta, Pa., Msgr. Baroni was graduated from Mount St. Mary's College and did his graduate work at the University of Notre Dame and the Catholic University of America. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1956. He became executive secretary of the Archbishop's Committee on Community Relations in 1965, then Executive Director of the Office of Urban Affairs for the Archdiocese of Washington, then Director of Program Development for Task Force on Urban Problems of the United States Catholic Conference and he is currently the Director of the National Center for Urban Ethnic Affairs. Long active in civil rights, urban affairs, ecumenical affairs, and other social concerns, he has served as consultant to many national and local groups in Washington.

WALTER F. GIBBONS

A Pawtucket native, he was graduated from Providence College in 1939 and from The Catholic University of America Law School in 1942. He is now senior partner in the firm of Armstrong, Gibbons, Black and Lodge. He has served on taxation committees for the Rhode Island Bar Association and American Bar Association, is a past president of the Providence College Alumni Association and is General Chairman of the Providence College Campaign for the Second Half-Century. He is a member of the Diocesan Committee for the Renewal of the Clergy, a member of the Corporation of Kent County Hospital, and a member of the Providence College Corporation.

MAX L. GRANT

Born in Providence, he was educated at Classical High School and Brown University. He became an industrialist, manufacturing products of his own invention, the best known of which are devices for the automatic collection of fares and tolls. Through the years he has matched his business achievements with a record of activity in cultural, charitable and civic affairs that saw him become first president of such organizations as Miriam Hospital, the Jewish Community Center, the Jewish Federation for Social Services; he was also first Jewish co-chairman for the National Conference of Christians and Jews for R.I.

JOHN SEVILLE HIGGINS

Bishop Higgins was born in London, England and received his B.A. and M.A. from Oberlin College and his B.D. from Seabury-Western Theological Seminary. After his ordination in 1931 he began his parish ministry in Evanston, Ill. in 1931, was called to Minneapolis in 1938 and to Providence in 1948. He became Bishop Coadjutor of the Episcopal Diocese of Rhode Island in 1953 and Bishop in 1955. An early ecumenical leader he became a member of the Joint Commission for Ecumenical Relations in 1952, the Anglican-Roman Catholic Commission in 1965, and of One Faith and Fellowship in 1967, and has been an outstanding leader in Rhode Island's civic and religious life.

SALVADOR EDWARD LURIA

Born in Torino, Italy, he received his Doctor of Medicine degree at the University of Torino. He joined the faculty of the University of Rome in 1938 as a Specialist in Radiology and Medical Physics to begin an academic career that was to win him the Nobel Prize in Medicine in 1969. He came to the United States in 1940 as a research assistant professor of Bacteriology, first to Columbia University, then to the University of Illinois. Since 1964 he has been Sedgwick Professor of Biology at Massachusetts Institute of Technology and since 1970 has held the additional title of Institute Professor. He is a distinguished author and lecturer.

ROBERT ARNOLD RIESMAN

Born in Chelsea, Mass., he was graduated from Harvard University, and holds an honorary degree from Hebrew University of Jerusalem. He served as President and Board Chairman of Royal Electric Co., Pawtucket, R.I., and President of Carol Cable Co. of Pawtucket, R.I. Mr. Riesman was Corporate Committee Chairman of Providence College's Capital Campaign for the Second Half-Century in 1969. He is a Member of the Board of Regents for Education for the State of Rhode Island and a Corporator of Roger Williams College. He has been honored with the Distinguished Civilian Service Medal for his services as civilian aide to the Secretary of the Army for Rhode Island.

JAMES EDWARD CHEEK

Born in Roanoke Rapids, N.C., he was graduated from Shaw University in 1955. He received a Bachelor of Divinity degree in 1958 from the Colgate-Rochester Divinity School and a Ph.D., from Drew University in 1962. He was an assistant professor of New Testament and Historical Theology at Virginia Union University when he was named president of Shaw University in 1963. In 1969 he became president of Howard University. He is a member of many national and local commissions in Washington, D.C. He is on the board of directors of many educational business and cultural institutions, and a trustee of numerous organizations, including the American Association of Higher Education.
