

A native of Orange, Mass., he was graduated from Brown University in 1924, won a Graduate Fellowship at Juilliard School of Music, New York City, and did further graduate study at the State Academy of Music in Vienna, Austria. He then joined the faculty at Brown and served for thirty-two years as Chairman of the Department of Music, during which he was also at various times Conductor of the Brown University Orchestra, Director of the Brown University Glee Club and Director of the Pembroke College Glee Club. He is an incorporator of the Rhode Island Philharmonic Orchestra, a Founder of Arts Rhode Island, a trustee of Trinity Square Repertory Company, a Board Member of the R.I. Federation of Music Clubs and a Member of the Corporation of the R.I. Civic Chorale and Orchestra.

WILLIAM F. FLANAGAN

Dr. Flanagan, a native of Warwick, was graduated from Providence College, took his M.Ed. at Rhode Island College and his Ph.D. at the University of Connecticut. Beginning as a teacher at Lockwood High School, he became vice principal, then principal of Aldrich High School before returning to Rhode Island College in 1956 as Professor of Education. Two years later he took on additional duties as Director of the Graduate Studies Program and remained there until 1964 when he was named President of Rhode Island Junior College and President of the Rhode Island System of Junior Colleges. He is currently president of the New England Junior College Council and a member of many educational commissions. He is a member of the corporation of Providence College, of Rhode Island Hospital and of Blue Cross and a director of Kent County Hospital and People's Savings Bank.

GERALD F. JONES, SR.
Born in Bronx, N.Y., he was graduated from Morris High School and Birds Business School, both of Bronx, N.Y. In 1926 he started work as a mailboy with Mack Trucks, Incorporated. He became successively a salesman, an assistant division manager, a division manager, a vice president for sales, vice president for marketing, executive vice president for marketing, senior vice president for marketing, and in 1972 he was elected Vice Chairman of the Board of Mack Trucks, Incorporated. He has been a member of the President's Council of Providence College since 1968. He now lives in Morristown, N.J.

JEWEL STRADFORD LAFONTANT

Mrs. Lafontant was born in Chicago, received her early schooling there and was graduated from Oberlin College and the University of Chicago Law School. She became a partner in the law firm of Stradford, Lafontant, Fisher and Malkin and was elected to the Board of Directors of Trans World Airlines, of Jewel Companies and of Foote, Cone and Belding. She served as Assistant United States Attorney from 1955 to 1958. A representative to the 37th General Assembly of the United Nations, she has now been designated as Deputy Solicitor General of the United States. She has been chairman of the Illinois Advisory Committee to the U.S. Civil Rights Commission, vice chairman of the U.S. Advisory Commission of International, Educational and Cultural Affairs and a member of the President's Committee on Minority Enterpris-

WILLIAM A. WALLACE, O.P.

Father Wallace, a New Yorker, was graduated from Manhattan College in 1940, enlisted in the Navy and rose to the rank of Lieutenant Commander. After World War II he entered the Dominican Order, received his Master of Science in Physics from The Catholic University of America, his Ph.D. and S.T.D. from the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, and his Master of Sacred Theology from Santa Sabina, Rome. He taught at several Dominican Houses of Philosophy, then became editor of the New Catholic Encyclopedia at Catholic University. For two years he was research associate in the History of Science Department at Harvard University, then became Regent of Studies at the Dominican House of Studies in Washington. Since 1970 he has been Professor of History and Philosophy of Science at The Catholic University of America and is Director of the National Science Foundation's Summer Institutes for College Teachers of Science, and a member of the Providence College Corporation.

MORTIMER J. ADLER

Mr. Adler received his education in his native New York at Columbia University where he began teaching in 1923 and where he took his Ph.D. in 1928. He joined the faculty of the University of Chicago in 1930 and held the rank of Professor-at-Large until 1952. He is at present the Director of the Institute for Philosophical Research, Director of Editorial Planning for the Encyclopedia Brittanica, Editor-in-Chief of the Syntopicon of the Great Books, and Director of the Great Books Foundation. He has contributed many articles to philosophical publications, and has achieved further literary distinction as the author of seventeen widely-acclaimed books. He is a member of the American Catholic Philosophical Association and the Thomistic Institute of America.
