#### HUMBERTO CARDINAL MEDEIROS

At the age of sixteen he came to Fall River, Mass., from his native Portuguese Azores, where he had attended elementary school. He enrolled in the Border City School in Fall River, learned the English language and was graduated from Durfee High School with honors in 1937. He studied for the priesthood at The Catholic University of America and was ordained in Fall River in 1946. He took his M.A. in Philosophy at Catholic University in 1942 and his Doctorate in Sacred Theology in 1951. He served in parish work in Fall River, became vice chancellor, then chancellor of the Diocese, then pastor of St. Michael's Parish. He was named second Bishop of Brownsville, Texas, by Pope Paul VI in 1966. In 1970 he was named to succeed Richard Cardinal Cushing as Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Boston, the second largest See in the United States. In 1973 Pope Paul VI named him to the Sacred College of Cardinals.

#### ROBERT CHARLES GALLO

A native of Waterbury, Conn., he received his A.B. in Biology, summa cum laude, at Providence College in 1959 and his M.D. at Jefferson Medical School in 1963, then served his internship and Residency in Medicine at the University of Chicago. In 1965 he became a clinical associate at the National Cancer Institute at Bethesda, Md., where he is now Chief of the Laboratory of Tumor Cell Biology, Experimental Therapeutics. He is also Adjunct Professor of Genetics at George Washington University, an editor of the Year Book of Cancer, is active in many scientific societies and is the author of numerous publications. He is married to the former Mary Jane Hayes and they have two children.

#### FRANK J. MCGEE

He received his early schooling in his birthplace, Woonsocket, then took his undergraduate degree at Providence College and his LL.B. at Boston University School of Law. He has been in the private practice of law in Providence since 1928 and is a member of the Rhode Island Bar Association, the American Bar Association, the Trial Lawyers Association and the Association of College and University Attorneys. He served the Providence College Corporation as secretary from March of 1966 until he retired in June of 1973. Long active in the Providence College Alumni Association he is a former member of its Board of Governors. He and Mrs. McGee, the former Eleanor Wynn, have three sons.

#### FLORENCE KERINS MURRAY

Newport was her birthplace and is still her home. After her early schooling there she was graduated from Syracuse University and the Boston University Law School and then saw three years of active service with the U.S. Army during World War II. She holds the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in the Honorary Reserve. After the war she entered the private practice of law and served in the Rhode Island State Senate from 1948 to 1956 when she was named to the Rhode Island Superior Court as an Associate Justice. She has served on numerous civic, legal and public affairs commissions and is currently Chairman of the Rhode Island Committee for the Humanities, a member of the National Board of the Girls Clubs of America and secretary of the Board of Directors of Rhode Island Blue Shield.

#### CHARLES TERENCE QUINN, O.P.

Born in Astoria, New York, he received his early education there and in Brooklyn and took his B.S. degree at Dartmouth College. He served four years in the United States Navy and was discharged with the rank of Ensign. He entered the Dominican Novitiate in 1948, completed his philosophical and theological studies at the Dominican House of Studies, Washington, D.C., and was ordained in 1955. He served a year on the faculty of Providence College and then volunteered for service in the Dominican Missions in the Diocese of Multan, Pakistan in 1957. In 1964 he became Vicar Provincial of the Dominican Mission in Pakistan and remained in that post until he was elected Provincial of the Dominican Province of St. Joseph in 1972. This Province encompasses the eastern third of the United States. On June 24, 1973, he was elected Chairman of the Providence College Corporation.

#### JAMES N. WILLIAMS

Born in Des Moines, Iowa, he was graduated from Des Moines University and took his M.A. at New Jersey State Teachers College at Montclair. After thirteen years in Y.M.C.A. work in New York and New Jersey he came to Providence in 1940 as Executive Director of the Urban League of Rhode Island, a post he held for thirty years until his retirement in 1970. He is still active as consultant in community relations to the Urban League and is host and moderator of a television program for senior citizens, produced by the Rhode Island Department of Education. He has served on scores of national, state and local commissions concerned with community relations and social welfare and has won many honors for his work in these areas. Married to the former Nellie L. Davis, they have a son and a daughter.

#### ELLIOT LEE RICHARDSON

A Bostonian, he was graduated cum laude from Harvard College in 1941 and from Harvard Law School cum laude in 1947. In the years between he enlisted in the U.S. Army as a private, served in the European Theater of Operations and was discharged as a first lieutenant. After law school he served as clerk to Judge Learned Hand for a year and then to Judge Felix Frankfurter before joining the Boston law firm of Ropes, Gray, Best, Coolidge and Rugg, where he eventually became a partner. A long career in state and federal service saw him reach the Cabinet level in 1970 when he became Secretary of Health, Education and Welfare, later Secretary of Defense and then Attorney General of the United States, a post which he resigned on October 20, 1973. He is currently a fellow at the Woodrow Wilson Center for Scholars. Mrs. Richardson is the former Anne F. Hazard of Peace Dale, R.I. They have three children.
