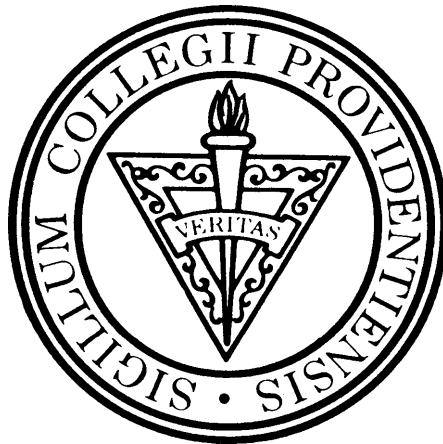

ADE BETHUNE

Arriving in the United States in 1928, the Belgium-born artist was educated at the National Academy of Design, the Cooper Union Day Arts Schools, and Boston's Connick Studios. Her early illustrations of Dorothy Day's *The Catholic Worker* sparked what was to become a life-long interest in sacred iconography and its place in the liturgy. She continued her work as an illustrator for *Christian Life, Worship, My Sunday Missal, and My Lenten Missal*, and later founded the St. Leo Shop in Newport in response to the growing demand for her drawings of the saints. Today, she employs her expertise in the fields of acoustics, lighting, seating and sacred images as a liturgical consultant with Bethune-Dutra Associates of Newport, who involve themselves in the renovation of old churches as well as the planning and designing of new structures. Her work in church decoration and design can be seen internationally, with representation in the Phillipines, Mexico, and throughout the United States. In 1977 she was awarded the Maurice A. Lavanoux Award by the New England Liturgical Committee, and was recently featured in the *World Who's Who of Women*. She now resides in Newport, where she cultivates a special interest in solar heating for energy conservation.

DR. FRANK DiTRAGLIA

A 1940 alumnus of Providence College, he pursued a dual career as physician and attorney, providing the medical and legal professions with a unique combination of expertise. After receiving his medical degree from St. Louis University School of Medicine, he served as a medical officer in the U.S. Air Force during World War II. After the war he established a private practice of general medicine in New York City, before being recalled to duty during the Korean War. While serving as Chief of the Outpatient Department at Bolling Air Force Base in Washington, D.C., he received his Juris Doctor degree from the Catholic University School of Law. He resumed his private practice in Washington, D.C. from 1954-1958 before joining the Food and Drug Administration as a medical officer. In 1959, he began his long and successful career with the international pharmaceutical firm of Warner Lambert, where he quickly became known as the company's medical-legal specialist. After 20 years of service in various administrative positions, he retired in 1979 as Warner Lambert's Corporate Vice President for Medical Affairs World Wide. A native New Yorker, he now resides in Cranbury, New Jersey, where he practices medicine part-time and serves as a consultant to pharmaceutical companies.

BARBARA KIEFER LEWALSKI

One of the few women on the Brown University faculty to hold full professorship, she has been called "one of the greatest scholars in the Renaissance field in our century." An authority on 17th century literature, the Chicago, Illinois native received her early education at Emporium State University, and following graduate studies at the University of Chicago and the University of London, began her teaching career at Wellesley College. She was appointed to the faculty at Brown in 1956, and is presently Professor of English Literature, Alumni-Almuna Professor. She also chairs the new program in Renaissance studies which she helped to establish. Her reputation as a scholar was recently recognized by Harvard University, where she was offered the William R. Kenan professorship of History and Literature, and of English Literature for the Fall, 1982. She presently serves on four editorial boards including *Studies in English Literature* and *Milton Studies*, and is a member of the executive council of the American Language Association. In 1980 she was awarded the James Russell Lowell Prize — one of the highest honors an English scholar can receive — by the Modern Language Association. She has received a Guggenheim fellowship and a Fulbright Travel Grant for the pursuit of her studies. She resides in Providence with her husband and son.

DAVE McKENNA

During the early years of his career as a jazz pianist, fellow musicians, impressed with his talents, regarded him as "the best kept secret in American jazz circles." In the past decade, the public has come to share that early appraisal, making him one of the most respected and acclaimed musicians of his era. Appearing in virtually all of the major jazz clubs from coast-to-coast, he has performed with and recorded along side such jazz giants as Woody Herman, Louis Armstrong, Gene Krupa and Bobby Hackett, who called him the "greatest piano player in the world." As both soloist and sideman, he has performed at Carnegie Hall, Boston's Symphony Hall and at the Newport Jazz Festivals in both New York and Rhode Island. Overseas concert tours have taken him to Europe, the British Isles, Japan, and most recently, Australia. With over three-dozen albums to his credit, the Woonsocket, Rhode Island, native was recently featured on the nationally televised PBS special with Tony Bennett and the legendary Count Basie. He makes his home on Cape Cod, with his wife and two sons.

REVEREND BRUCE RITTER, O.F.M.

As founder and president of the internationally known child care agency, Covenant House, and of its equally well-known crisis center, Under 21, he has attained national prominence as the purveyor of what he calls a "muscular christianity." Following service in the U.S. Navy, the Trenton, New Jersey native was ordained a Franciscan priest in 1956. Awarded a doctorate degree in Medieval Theology from the Pontifical Theological Faculty in Rome, he later taught at St. Anthony-on-the-Hudson, St. John's University, St. Hyacinth College, and finally Manhattan College before beginning his ministry of "availability" among the urban poor on New York City's Lower East Side. The center operates round-the-clock on a "no questions asked" basis, offering food, shelter and a number of services to the more than 12,000 homeless runaway and sexually-exploited adolescents who come through its doors every year. In July of 1981, Covenant House opened its first overseas mission for the homeless shoeshine boys of Antigua, Guatemala. As a recognized authority on runaways, his work has been documented by every form of the media including *The New York Times*, *U.S. News and World Report*, *Time Magazine*; television's *Sixty Minutes*; and Providence's *WEAN-AM* radio. He is the recipient of numerous awards, including the National Jefferson Award, and the Service to Youth Award from the New York State Division for Youth.

ROMUALD SPASOWSKI

As former Ambassador of Poland to the United States, he has chartered one of the most distinguished diplomatic careers in post-war Poland. Born in 1920, he is the son of a leading Polish leftist intellectual. He studied physics at Warsaw University's College of Mechanics, and following his father's death, escaped to the Soviet Union. Convinced that Communism held great promise for Poland, he served as an officer in the Polish army division formed in the Soviet Union, and after the war, entered Polish government service investigating the Nazi war crimes. In his first major foreign post, he served as counselor in the Polish Embassy in London, followed by two years as Ambassador to Argentina. He began his first U.S. tour in 1955 as the youngest foreign ambassador in Washington. He left this position in 1961 to serve as Poland's envoy to India, and during the mid-seventies, filled the no. 2 position in the Polish foreign ministry. He returned to Washington for his second tour of duty in 1978. As his influence grew, so did his doubts in Polish Communism. Since his wife is an ardent Catholic, the election of a Polish Pope affected him profoundly. The rise of Solidarity also fired his sense of Polish nationalism, and he began to bank on the hope that the government could reform itself. These hopes were shattered by the imposition of martial law in December, 1981, bringing a "reign of terror" down on the country which he regards as a most flagrant violation of human rights. This, combined with the imprisonment of Lech Walesa, the leader of the country's free trade union, brought about his resignation on December 20, 1981. He sees the resignation as his expression of solidarity with Walesa. Today he lives with his wife, daughter and son-in-law under political asylum in the United States.

LECH WALESZA

Under his leadership, Poland's best known union organizer has guided Solidarity's free trade union movement through a perilous, persistent crusade for freedom and a better way of life for the people of Poland. Recognized as a moderator who takes a cautious approach toward effecting change from the Polish Communist government, he was born during the Nazi occupation in the village of Popow, between Warsaw and Gdansk. The son of a carpenter, he learned the electrician's trade at the state vocational school in Lupino, where his leadership skills emerged and were cultivated. In 1967 he began working as an electrician at the Lenin shipyards in Gdansk - the birthplace of Solidarity. Because of his relentless efforts to organize an independent union, he was jailed numerous times and finally fired from his job in 1980. That same year, the Polish government raised meat prices, which sparked a string of protest and prompted him to head an interfactory strike committee that eventually became the bargaining representative of some 500,000 strikers. After much negotiating, the government finally yielded to almost all the workers' demands, and he and other ex-strike leaders found themselves challenged by the task of organizing and controlling a loosely-knit labor federation that numbered ten million members. However, in the months that followed, the government's continued failure to deal with the country's state of economic paralysis caused impatience among inexperienced rank and file activists, giving rise to inevitable confrontation. Poland's seventeen-month awakening came to an abrupt halt when the government raided Solidarity headquarters, arrested its leaders, and imposed a state of martial law. Since then, the Communist regime's leading critic has been interned in a government guest house, with one exception: he was permitted a two-day visit with his wife, Danuta, and their new daughter who was born during her father's confinement.

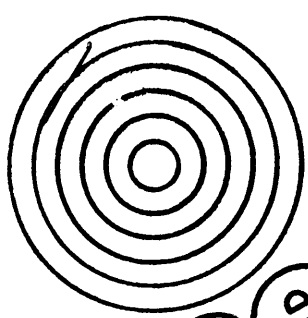

Romuald Spasowski, former Polish Ambassador to the United States, informed Providence College on Thursday, May 13, that he would be unable to attend Providence College's Commencement exercises at the Providence Civic Center on May 17.

Mr. Spasowski was scheduled to deliver the principal address to the graduates and to receive an honorary Doctor of Laws degree in absentia for Solidarity leader Lech Walesa. Expressing his deepest regrets, the former ambassador said that he "will be indisposed for reasons of health."

Monsignor George G. Higgins, one of the Church's foremost social action leaders, has agreed to address the graduates and to accept the honorary degree for the interned Walesa.

Born in Chicago in 1916, Monsignor Higgins studied for the priesthood at St. Mary of the Lake Seminary, Mundelein, Chicago, from 1934-1939. Following his ordination in 1940 as a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago, he attended the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC, where he received both his MA (1942) and Ph.D (1944) in labor economics.

In 1944, he began his 36-year association with the National Conference of Catholic Bishops/ United States Catholic Conference, the coordinating body of Catholic Bishops in the United States, based in Washington, DC. (Prior to Vatican II, USCC was called the National Catholic Welfare Conference.)

Monsignor Higgins held numerous positions in the social action field of USCC, including director of social action, secretary of research and secretary for special concerns. While working in these capacities he became widely respected in the trade union movement, working towards labor reform with the farmworkers in California, textile workers in the south, mine workers in Appalachia, and Catholic hospital employers across the country.

His involvement with the farmworkers' struggle, which resulted in the formation of the United Farmworkers, is regarded as Monsignor Higgins greatest single contribution to labor reform.

In September, 1980, he retired from USCC and returned to Catholic University to teach part-time in the Department of Theology. However, he has continued to devote most of his time to civil rights and is a leading participant in social reform movements throughout the country and most recently, in Poland.

A strong supporter of Poland's Solidarity movement, he was the principal celebrant at the Mass which officially opened Solidarity's First National Congress in Gdansk last October.

Through more than four decades of working for social reform, he has become regarded as a consistent and concise voice for social justice and world peace.
