

#### HOWARD C. BEDFORD

As chairman and chief executive officer of Bedford Associates, Inc., a subsidiary of British Airways, Howard Bedford is responsible for the overall operation of the worldwide information technology and consulting company he founded a decade ago. Bedford, whose data processing career spans nearly forty years, first worked as a mathematician for Sperry Gyroscope in Long Island, followed by a position as a computer programmer for North American Aviation in Los Angeles. He joined IBM as a project manager in 1959 and was in charge of all software developed for controlling the Mercury, Gemini, and Apollo manned space flights. He also served as director of IBM's Airlines Program Office, responsible for the development and installation of the worldwide airline reservation systems. In 1968 Bedford founded Greenwich Data Systems, a software systems company which was later acquired by Control Data Corporation. Prior to founding Bedford Associates in 1980, Bedford also served for two years as a senior vice president in charge of the Advanced Systems Division for Federal Express Corporation. Bedford, who earned his bachelor's degree in math at Fordham University and a master's in math at New York University, has four sons who are PC graduates. Through the generous benefaction of the Bedford family, the former East Building on lower campus was renovated. The 65-bed women's dormitory was renamed Bedford Hall in June 1988.

#### MORRIS S. DEES, JR.

Viewing the law as a vehicle for social justice, Morris Dees has directed his energy toward the defense of civil rights for the impoverished and minorities in the South. In 1971 he co-founded the Southern Poverty Law Center in Montgomery, Alabama, a non-profit organization which seeks to advance legal rights through education and litigation. The center is also known for its Klanwatch Project, an extensive, nationwide monitoring program to collect information on white supremacist activities. During the past 25 years, he has been involved in over fifty complex federal civil rights cases, many involving appeals to federal circuit courts and the U.S. Supreme Court. In one of his most notable cases, Dees secured a \$7 million jury award in federal court in behalf of the mother of a young black man who was lynched by the Ku Klux Klan. The verdict represented the first time that a Klan organization had been held liable for the violent acts of its members. A graduate of the University of Alabama School of Law, Dees is also the center's chief trial counsel. Dees has received a number of awards for his work in civil litigation, including the American Bar Association's Young Lawyers Distinguished Service Award; the Alabama Civil Liberties Union Award for Outstanding Devotion to Individual Rights; the Alabama State NAACP Award; and the Tuskegee Institute's Outstanding Service for Human Rights Award. He was also named the Trial Lawyer of the Year in 1987 by Trial Lawyers for Public Justice.

#### **DONAL HENAHAN**

A pianist and classical guitarist, Donal Henahan has served as chief music critic of the New York *Times* since 1980. He joined the *Times* music staff in 1967 after serving ten years as music critic of the Chicago *Daily News*. A native of Cleveland, Ohio, Henahan served in World War II from 1942 to 1945 as a fighter pilot with the Eighth Air Force in England. Separated from the service at the rank of First Lieutenant, Henahan was decorated with the Air Medal with three oak leaf clusters. He studied music, anthropology, and romance languages at Kent State University and Ohio University and earned his bachelor's degree in music and journalism from Northwestern. Henahan also pursued graduate studies in cultural anthropology and music at the University of Chicago, where he later became a part-time member of the faculty. His reviews have appeared in a wide range of publications, including *Music Quarterly, Esquire, Harper's Bazaar*, and *Gramophone*, among many others. The recipient of a Pulitizer Prize for criticism in 1986, Henahan was also a 1983 Poynter Fellow of Yale University. He also served a three year term as a member of the visiting committee to the Department of Music at the University of Chicago.

#### MOST REVEREND EMERSON J. MOORE, D.D.

Born in Harlem, Emerson Moore grew up in the South Bronx and graduated from Cardinal Hayes High School. He entered the Minor Seminary at Cathedral College in Manhattan, where he studied for two years before transferring to St. Joseph's Seminary in Dunwoodie, Yonkers, NY. Ordained in 1964 just two weeks after his 26th birthday, Father Moore was first assigned to St. Augustine's in Ossining. He then served as assistant pastor at the Church of the Holy Family, where he assumed pastoral responsibility for the Catholic Interracial Council, the Urban League, and the NAACP. Father Moore was named executive director of the Lt. Joseph P. Kennedy Jr. Memorial Community Center in Harlem in 1968, and he assumed the additional duty of director of the Central Harlem Office of Catholic Charities. In 1975 he was appointed pastor of St. Charles Borromeo Church in Harlem. Founder and current chairman of the Office of Black Ministry for the Archdiocese of New York, Father Moore received his master's degree in public administration at New York

University and a degree in social work from Columbia. In 1978 he was named a Monsignor, and in 1982 he was elevated to Auxiliary Bishop of New York, becoming the first black bishop in the Archdiocese. That same year he was appointed Vicar of Central Harlem and Vicar of Black Community Development throughout the Archdiocese of New York. Bishop Moore was appointed Vicar for Social Development for the Archdiocese in 1987, responsible for housing, peace and justice issues, community development, and refugee and immigrant services.

#### DONALD F. PETERSEN

A former chairman of the board and chief executive officer of Ford Motor Company, Donald Petersen has earned widespread recognition for his leadership of the country's second-largest automaker. During his more than forty-year career at Ford, Petersen held a variety of positions, including five years as chairman and five years as president. Under his direction, Ford became the most profitable automaker in history. Born in Pipestone, Minnesota, Petersen earned a bachelor's degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Washington and a master's degree in business administration from Stanford University. He served as a member of the U.S. Marine Corps in World War II and the Korean War. Beginning his association with Ford in 1949, Petersen worked extensively in the company's car product planning, research and marketing operations before being named Ford's president in March 1980, when the company was reporting tremendous losses for the second straight year. Under Petersen's leadership the giant automaker was turned around, becoming one of the most profitable corporations in the world in less than a decade. Frequently cited for his incisive skills as a businessman and for his humanitarian service to the community, Petersen was named the most effective chief executive in 1988 by Fortune 500. Named Motor Trend magazine's "Man of the Year" in 1987, Petersen has received the B'Nai B'rith "Champion of Youth Award"; the National Humanitarian Award from the National Jewish Center for Immunology and Respiratory Medicine: and the Business Statesman Award for the Harvard Business School Club of Detroit, among many others.

#### ARTHUR F. RYAN

A 1963 alumnus of Providence College, Arthur Ryan has progressed through the corporate ranks of finance to become a vice chairman and a director of the Chase Manhattan Corporation and its principal subsidiary, The Chase Manhattan Bank, N.A. Ryan joined Chase in 1972 as a project manager in the Data Processing Division of the Operations Department and was appointed second vice president in 1973. He was promoted to vice president in 1974, and the following year he was named Data Processing Division executive in the Securities and Investment Processing Division. Ryan was named operations executive in 1978 and was appointed executive vice president and function executive in 1982, when Chase formed a new bankwide Corporate Operations and Systems group. Ryan was an area manager for Control Data Corporation in Washington, D.C., before joining Chase. A native of Brooklyn, New York, Ryan attended graduate school at American University while serving as a lieutenant in the U.S. Army. Active in a host of organizations, Ryan is a trustee of Pace University and chairman of the executive advisory board of the university's Center for the Study of Financial Services. He is a past president of the New York State Bankers Association and is currently a member of the Business Advisory Council of the Carnegie Mellon Graduate School of Industrial Administration. He is also a member of the board of trustees of the Presbyterian Hospital in New York City.

#### SISTER MARY CHRISTINE TAYLOR, S.S.J.

Known as a beloved friend of the Mohawk Indians of upstate New York, Sister Mary Christine Taylor has dedicated her life to helping the Mohawk tribe develop educationally, socially and spiritually. Born and raised in Ogdensburg, New York, Sister Taylor entered the religious order of the Sisters of St. Joseph in 1948 and made her final profession of vows in 1954. After teaching elementary and secondary school for several years, she served as founder/coordinator of St. Francis Xavier College Church Neighborhood Improvement Program for Ghetto Negro Poor, which she ran until 1967. She later served as president of the board of the St. Lawrence County Community Development Program for the poor and as chairman of the St. Lawrence County Council on Adult Continuing Education. In 1962 Sister Taylor became associated with Mater Dei College in Ogdensburg, where she served as chairman of the history department, vice president for academic affairs, academic dean and director of the Higher Education Opportunity Program for Disadvantaged. She founded the St. Regis Mohawk Indian Reservation branch campus of Mater Dei College in 1973, and has served as its director since then. As director she oversees all educational and social services offered to the Indians, many of which are now run by her graduates. She is also involved in pastoral ministry at the St. Regis Indian Mission Church. Sister Taylor earned her bachelor's degree in education at Villanova University and her doctorate in American Studies at St. Louis University.
