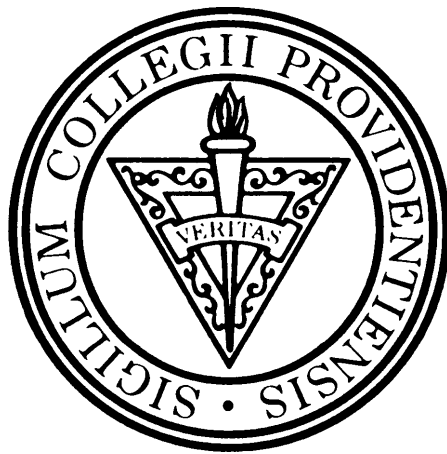

HIS SERENE HIGHNESS PRINCE HANS-ADAM II

His Serene Highness Prince Hans-Adam II is head of state of Liechtenstein, a tiny sovereign principality on the upper Rhine between Austria and Switzerland. The son of Prince Franz Josef II and Princess Gina, Hans-Adam II was born and educated in Switzerland and served as chief executive officer of Liechtenstein from 1970 to 1983. In 1984 he was granted executive power by his father and given responsibility to serve as deputy head of state of his country. Upon the death of Prince Franz Josef in 1989 — after a 51-year reign that made him the world's most durable monarch — the throne was immediately succeeded by the 44-year-old Prince Hans-Adam II. A business school graduate with an avid interest in both domestic and foreign relations, Hans-Adam II realized a longtime goal in September 1990 when his country became a member of the United Nations. In 1991, he guided Liechtenstein to admission as the seventh full member of the European Free Trade Association. Geographically one of the smallest nations in the world, Liechtenstein measures about 61 square miles and has a population of about 26,000, mostly Roman Catholics. It is one of the world's richest countries, boasting the third-highest per capita income. Post-World War II industrialization, particularly in metallurgy and light industry, brought the country to affluence. Today, under the guidance of Hans-Adam II, Liechtenstein continues to flourish and build upon its solid economic base with the sale of its own postage stamps, the manufacture of false teeth, and the liberal tax policies that have made the country a popular headquarters for foreign businesses. It has also become a mecca for tourists, with its ski resorts attracting such international figures as Britain's Prince Charles and Lady Diana.

J. TERRENCE MURRAY

A native of Woonsocket, RI and a 1962 alumnus of Harvard University, J. Terrence Murray has progressed through the corporate ranks of banking to become chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Fleet/Norstar Financial Group, Inc., and director of Fleet/Norstar. Murray joined Fleet/Norstar in 1962, serving in several of Fleet National Bank's branches and departments until being elected president of Fleet Financial Group and the bank in 1978. He was named chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Fleet Financial Group and the bank in 1982, and has served as a director of Fleet Financial Group since 1976 and a director of the bank since 1977. (Fleet Financial Group, Inc. of Providence and Norstar Bancorp of Albany, NY merged on January 1, 1988 to become Fleet/Norstar.) Murray was appointed a director and member of the Executive Committee of the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston in 1989, is director of the Association of Reserve City Bankers, and has served as chairman of its Government Relations Committee. He is also a former member of the Federal Advisory Council of the Federal Reserve System, has served on the Government Relations Council of the American Bankers Association, and is a former member of the board of directors, Executive Committee, Emerging Issues Committee, and chairman of the Membership Committee of the Association of Bank Holding Companies. Active in a host of other organizations, Murray is a director of the A.T. Cross Company in Lincoln, RI and the State Mutual Life Assurance Company of America in Worcester, MA. He is a former chairman of the Executive Committee of the Coalition of Northeastern Governors and served as chairman of the Rhode Island Strategic Development Commission. He currently serves as a trustee of the Rhode Island School of Design, is director of the Harvard Alumni Association, and serves on the Committee for University Resources at Harvard. Named "New England Businessperson of the Year for 1991" by *New England Business* magazine, Murray received the Humanitarian Award from the Fogarty Foundation in 1991 and was the 1990 recipient of the "New Englander of the Year Award" from The New England Council. He was awarded the 1988 Humanitarian Award by the National Jewish Center for Immunology and Respiratory Medicine, and presented with the Jewish Federation's "Never Again Award" in 1989. Murray holds an honorary doctor of laws degree from the University of Rhode Island (1990) and honorary doctor of business administration degrees from Bryant College (1989), Johnson & Wales University (1984), and Roger Williams College (1983).

ANTONIA C. NOVELLO, M.D., M.P.H.

A longtime advocate for the betterment of public health and public health services in the United States, particularly where children are concerned, Antonia C. Novello, M.D., M.P.H. was appointed the 14th Surgeon General of the United States by President George Bush in 1990. She is the first woman and first Hispanic to serve in this capacity. A native of Puerto Rico, Novello received a bachelor's degree in biology from the University of Puerto Rico in 1965, and received her medical degree in 1970 from the University of Puerto Rico School of Medicine in San Juan. She served an internship and residence in pediatrics at the University of Michigan Medical Center in Ann Arbor, MI, and completed postgraduate training in nephrology at the University of Michigan Medical Center and Georgetown University Hospital in Washington, DC. Novello joined the National Institute of Health, Bethesda, MD, in 1978 and rose through the ranks to serve most recently as deputy director of NIH's National Institute of Child Health and Human Development (NICHD), coordinator for AIDS research for NICHD, and director of NICHD's Division of Extramural Programs. In addition, she has served concurrently as a clinical professor of pediatrics at Georgetown University Hospital and the University of Health Sciences in Bethesda. A member of numerous academic, medical, and hospital committees, as well as a member of editorial boards of prestigious medical journals, Novello has also been active in military service. She joined the United States Public Health Service (Active Reserve) in 1978 as a lieutenant and has been a captain with the Public Health Service (Regular Corps) since 1984. The recipient of many honors and awards, Novello was presented with the U.S. Public Health Service Achievement Award in 1990, and is listed in *Who's Who in America* (1987), *Who's Who of American Women* (1987), and *American Men and Women of Science* (1988). She is a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatrics and a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics.

THE MOST REVEREND ZACCHAEUS OKOTH, D.D.

A leader in the ongoing struggle for peace and justice in his native Kenya, The Most Reverend Zacchaeus Okoth, archbishop of Kisumu, has shown a deep concern for the holistic development of the people of his archdiocese through his many energetic efforts on their behalf. Currently president of the Conference of Catholic Bishops in Kenya and most recently chair of the conference's Commission on Peace and Justice, Archbishop Okoth has implemented many projects throughout his archdiocese to improve the academic, social, and economic development of his people. His construction of Catholic hospitals has also provided much-needed medical services for all of the people of Western Kenya. During the fourteen years of his episcopacy, Archbishop Okoth has established

17 of the 26 parishes within the Archdiocese of Kisumu. His pastoral vision as ordinary has led to the establishment of a Religious Education Awareness Program for primary and secondary school teachers. The archbishop has also been very helpful in the efforts of the Dominican Order to establish a permanent presence in East Africa. Archbishop Okoth studied philosophy and theology at St. Thomas Aquinas Seminary in Nairobi, which at that time was staffed by the Dominican Fathers of St. Joseph's Province. Following his ordination to the priesthood in November 1968, Archbishop Okoth completed two parish assignments before pursuing graduate studies in Rome, where he received his licentiate degree in theology. He then returned to Kenya, where he taught in the seminary in Nairobi. In 1975 he established St. Augustine's Seminary for philosophical studies. Within just ten years of his priestly ordination, the archbishop's many talents were recognized by Pope Paul VI, who appointed him as bishop of Kisumu in April 1978. His efforts were again recognized in May 1990, when Pope John Paul II raised his diocese to the rank of an archdiocese.

THOMAS FRANKLIN O'MEARA, O.P.

Priest, professor, and author, Thomas Franklin O'Meara, O.P., has dedicated his life to sharing his theological and philosophical expertise and insights with others. The William K. Warren Professor of Theology at the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, IN, Father O'Meara is a prolific writer, having authored or edited a number of scholarly books, including *Church and Culture: German Catholic Theology, 1860-1914* (1991), *Fundamentalism: A Catholic Perspective* (1990), and *Theology of Ministry* (1983). He has also written hundreds of articles for theological journals. Born and raised in Des Moines, IA, Father O'Meara entered the Dominican Order in 1955 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1962. He holds graduate degrees in philosophy, theology, and ministry, and obtained a doctorate in fundamental theology from the University of Munich in West Germany in 1967. Prior to joining the faculty at Notre Dame in 1981, Father O'Meara was professor of systematic theology at Aquinas Institute in Dubuque, IA, a visiting professor at the Weston School of Theology in Cambridge, MA, a visiting professor of theology at the Seminary of Sts. Peter and Paul in Ibadan, Nigeria, and a visiting professor at the Wartburg Theological Seminary, in addition to other visiting professorships. Father O'Meara's belief in active involvement and dialogue has been demonstrated by his service as past president of the Catholic Theological Society of America, past president of the North American Paul Tillich Society, and as a member of the Commission on the Intellectual Life of the Dominican Order (1980-84). Today, he is a member of the American Academy of Religion and is chair of the Committee on Publications for the Catholic Theological Society of America, which honored him in 1991 with its prestigious John Courtney Murray Award.

REVEREND PETER L. POND

Father to 22 children, Reverend Peter L. Pond has opened his heart and home to many children desperately needing a stable, nurturing environment in which to grow and flourish. In addition to their four natural children, Reverend Pond and his wife, Shirley, have adopted four American children and 14 Cambodian children. Their Cambodian-born son, Arn Chorn-Pond, is a member of the Providence College Class of 1992 and will receive his bachelor's degree today. Reverend Pond is president and administrative officer of the Jefferson Center Foundation in Jefferson, NH, where he is responsible for fund raising, program development, and management of several international, multi-million dollar community development projects. Since 1979, the primary focus of these projects has been on peace and national reconciliation in Cambodia and among the Cambodian people. Long interested in the plight of these people, Reverend Pond developed the Cambodian Refugee Resettlement Program in New England in 1982 and formed the Cambodian Crisis Committee in 1983 and the Cambodian Educational Foundation in 1985. He organized the Cambodian Mission for Peace in 1987 and the following year developed the Cambodian Training Center, which specializes in human rights, community development, non-violent conflict resolution, and the negotiation process, among other things. Reverend Pond administers a Southeast Asian Big Brother/Sister Program on six college campuses in Rhode Island and founded the Southeast Asian Business Association in 1991. An ordained minister in the United Church of Christ, Reverend Pond is a graduate of Yale University and holds a bachelor of divinity degree and a master of sacred theology degree from Yale Divinity School. He serves as a minister to Cambodian refugees and is fluent in Spanish, Thai, and Cambodian. Reverend Pond is also a member of the board of directors of the Cambodian Documentation Commission and the Inter-Religious Mission for Peace in Cambodia.

ROBERT F. REILLY

Following his graduation from Providence College in 1942, Robert F. Reilly joined the U.S. Army at the height of America's involvement in World War II. In 1945, with the war effort behind him, Reilly decided to pursue his interest in business, becoming the controller for American Limoges China Corporation. This position would signal the beginning of a long and distinguished career in manufacturing and retailing for Reilly, during which time he earned a master of business administration degree from the City College of New York, served as vice president of Baldwin Lima Hamilton from 1953 to 1961, and held the position of executive vice president of Phillips Van Heusen Corporation from 1961 to 1986. Reilly was also a board member and member of the executive committee at Van Heusen. In 1986, he assumed the chairmanship of The Joseph & Feiss Company and was vice chairman of the International Fashion Apparel Company from 1988 to 1991. Today, Reilly is a consultant and investor in the apparel manufacturing and retailing industry. In addition to his professional responsibilities, Reilly has been a member of the Financial Executives Institute since 1961, and has been a loyal and dedicated member of the Providence College Alumni Association for more than four decades. He is a former member of the Providence College Corporation (1974-79) and the President's Council (1985-1988). In 1969, the Providence College National Alumni Association honored Reilly with its prestigious "Personal Achievement Award," and in 1980, he was inducted into the Providence College Athletic Hall of Fame for his achievements as a member of the basketball and baseball teams while an undergraduate. A generous benefactor of Providence College for many years, Reilly established in 1986 the Mary C. Reilly Scholarship Fund in memory of his late wife.
