#### JOHN BOWAB

The 30-year veteran producer-director has traveled far from his first project as producer of industrial shows for the Music Corporation of America. A director of such hit television shows as *Facts of Life*, *Benson*, *Empty Nest*, and *Full House*, John Bowab has directed more than 200 television sitcom productions, including his first show, *Soap*, the highly successful satire which first aired in 1979. Before venturing into television, he was associate producer of the Broadway productions of *Sweet Charity* and *Mame*. He went on to either direct or produce over 120 Broadway shows and national tour productions which featured some of the most famous stars of stage and screen, including Angela Lansbury, Gwen Verdon, Lana Turner, and Susan Hayward. His production of *The Unsinkable Molly Brown*, starring Debbie Reynolds, recently opened to rave reviews in Los Angeles, California. Highly respected in the entertainment field, Bowab is a member of Actors Equity Association, the Society of Stage Directors and Choreographers, and the Directors Guild of America. A native of Pawtucket, RI, Bowab received a bachelor of arts degree in education from Providence College in 1955. An active supporter of alma mater, Bowab has hosted a number of alumni receptions at his home. He has also established two scholarships at Providence College, with emphasis on support of Rhode Island residents who intend to pursue careers in theatre arts. For the past nine years, he has served on the California Governor's Committee for Employment of the Handicapped.

#### MOST REVEREND JAMES MICHAEL DEMPSEY, O.P.

Bishop James Michael Dempsey, O.P., retired Bishop of Sokoto, Nigeria, was one of the first three Dominican missionaries from St. Albert's Province to go to Nigeria, where in 1951 he was appointed pastor of St. Dominic's Parish in Yaba and superior of the new Dominican community there. As the mission grew, he served as vicar provincial from 1957 to 1959 and again from 1963 to 1967, this time living and working in Gusau. In 1958, he served as vica chairman of the Nigerian Marian Congress. Raised to the episcopacy and appointed Bishop of the Sokoto Diocese in July, 1967, Father Dempsey's episcopal consecration took place the following month in St. Pius V Church, Chicago, Illinois, under Cardinal John Cody, Archbishop of Chicago. Bishop Dempsey served the Sokoto Diocese for 18 years, retiring on January 1, 1985. The retired Bishop currently serves as an example of prayer, study, and service to men entering the Dominican Central Province's Novitiate House, located at his residence at St. Dominic Priory, Denver, Colorado. Ever ready to serve, he assists the archdiocese with the sacrament of Confirmation and ministers to the sick and those in need. Born in Providence, Rhode Island, he attended La Salle Academy and received a bachelor of arts degree in education from PC in 1935. He entered the St. Rose Priory Dominican Novitiate in August of that year, and made his first profession there a year later. He then studied philosophy and theology at the Dominican House of Studies in River Forest, Illinois, and in 1947, received a master of arts degree in English literature from De Paul University in Chicago. He was ordained to the priesthood on June 11, 1942 by Bishop Bernard Sheil at the Dominican Priory in River Forest.

#### DAVID R. GAVITT

Commissioner of the BIG EAST Conference and president of the ABA-USA, the governing body for national and international basketball in the United States, Gavitt has held virtually every position of prominence connected with college basketball. Following his graduation from Dartmouth College in 1959, Gavitt worked for a short time at AT&T in Washington, DC, before launching his career in sports as an assistant coach at Worcester Academy in Massachusetts, followed by four years as assistant coach at Providence College. He returned to Dartmouth in 1966 as an assistant coach, and was named head coach one year later. Returning to PC in 1969 as head coach, Gavitt also assumed the position of PC athletic director in 1971. During his tenure as PC coach, the Friars competed in five NCAA and three NIT tournaments. As coach of the 1973 squad, Gavitt secured PC's first Final Four berth by winning the Eastern Regional. For his coaching efforts, he was named New England Coach of the Year on five occasions. In 1979 Gavitt helped found the BIG EAST Conference, serving as its part-time commissioner. The following year, Gavitt was recognized internationally by being selected the 1980 U.S. Olympic Basketball Coach. When the United States boycotted the Olympic Games, Gavitt organized a Gold Medal series for his players, a tradition that continues today. As the nine-member consortium of schools in the BIG EAST Conference flourished, Gavitt stepped down from his post as AD at Providence in 1982 and was promoted from acting commissioner to commissioner of the BIG EAST Conference. A resident of Rumford, RI, he also served as chairman of the NCAA Men's Basketball Committee from 1982-1984.

#### THE VENERABLE SOMDECH MAHA GHOSANANDA

Recently named supreme Buddhist leader of Cambodian monks throughout the world, the Venerable Somdech Maha Ghosananda has been hailed as one of "the greatest among spiritual leaders." His work for peace and nonviolence, especially in his homeland of Cambodia and Cambodian refugee camps in surrounding Thailand, has earned him the title, "the Ghandi of Cambodia." At the invitation of the United Nations, Maha Ghosananda came to the United States in 1980 to represent the Khmer nation in exile here, and settled in Providence because it had an established Khmer community. But the Buddhist monk continues to travel throughout the world today, promoting peace and working on behalf of the Interreligious Mission for Peace in Cambodia, of which he is president. He has met with Pope John Paul II in Rome several times, and in 1986, traveled to Assisi, Italy, to participate with other world religious leaders in a massive prayer for peace. A Buddhist monk for more than 50 years, Maha Ghosananda received much of his early training in India, and then traveled to Buddhist centers throughout Southeast Asia. He was in Thailand during the Pol Pot regime, a coincidence that may have saved his life since an estimated 80,000 Buddhist monks were slaughtered under that regime. Meeting the first influx of Cambodian refugees into Thailand after Pol Pot took control of Cambodia, Maha Ghosananda distributed more than 40,000 leaflets on Buddha's discourse about the power of Metta (loving-kindness), and helped to establish schools and temples there. An accomplished linguist, he speaks English, French, Cambodian, Vietnamese, Laotian and Pali, among others. He is president of the Khmer Buddhist Society of New England, and head of the Cambodian Buddhist Temple in Providence.

#### WILLIAM T. O'HARA

President of Bryant College in Smithfield, Rhode Island since 1976 and currently a professor of management there, William T. O'Hara will retire this July, following more than a decade of distinguished service. His leadership has resulted in faculty and program expansion, an endowed faculty chair, a greatly increased endowment, a state-of-the-art computer center, a \$6.5 million student center, and the establishment of the Small Business Development Center. Prior to being named Bryant president, O'Hara served from 1972 to 1976 as president of Mount Saint Mary College in New York, where he was also professor of constitutional law. During this time, he was also a mediator/arbitrator for the Connecticut State Department of Education. Before this, O'Hara was associated with the University of Connecticut, serving as director of the Southeastern Campus of the university and as associate dean and associate professor of law, among other positions. A former consultant on federal legislation for the Association of American Law Schools, O'Hara, a 1955 graduate of Trinity College, received his juris doctor degree and master of laws degree in international law from Georgetown University Law Center in 1958, and a master of laws degree in legal education from New York University School of Law in 1966. A former trial attorney, he lectured on constitutional and criminal law at the American University School of Government and Public Administration. Active in the study of legal and higher education issues, his endeavors include serving as vice chair of the Commission on the Future of the Rhode Island Judicial System; as a member of the Board of Directors of the New England Board of Higher Education; and as a charter member of the National Collegiate Athletic Association Presidents Commission. The co-author of The Student/The College/The Law, O'Hara has also written numerous articles and edited three publications on legal and educational topics.

#### WILLIAM K. REILLY

A native of Decatur, Illinois, Reilly last December was selected by President George Bush to head the United States Environmental Protection Agency, bringing nearly 20 years of practical experience to his position as overall administrator of the EPA's ten national regions. Prior to this appointment, Reilly had served as president of the Conservation Foundation since 1973 and as president of the World Wildlife Fund since 1985, when the two organizations merged. Fluent in five languages, Reilly has traveled extensively in his work for international wildlife conservation, becoming internationally recognized for his skills as a pragmatic problem-solver. Reilly has strong ties to Fall River, Massachusetts, where his parents, natives of that city, lived until the Depression. Though he was born and received his early education in Illinois, he returned to Fall River to attend B.M.C. Durfee High School, graduating in 1958. Reilly received a bachelor's degree in history from Yale in 1962 and a degree in law from Harvard University in 1965. Following law school, Reilly worked as an attorney for the law firm of Ross & Hardies in Chicago. He served as a captain in the U.S. Army, before being named associate director of the Urban Policy Center, Urban America, Inc. & the National Urban Coalition. He was the senior staff member on the President's Council on Environmental Quality from 1970-1972, and served as executive director of the Task Force on Land Use and Urban Growth from 1972-1973. Reilly, who also earned a master's degree in urban planning at Columbia University, is the author of *The Use of Land: A Citizen's Policy Guide to Urban Growth*, published in 1973.

#### MAY SARTON

A gifted poet, novelist, essayist and non-fiction writer of memoirs and journals, May Sarton has dedicated her entire lifetime to literature. Recently celebrating her 77th birthday with the publication of her 46th book, Miss Sarton has emerged as one of the most courageous and prolific writers of American literature in the 20th century, living a life of solitude devoted almost exclusively to creating her art. Contemporaries describe her as the grand matriarch of poetry and fiction, and as one who has kept alive the tradition of journal writing, a genre which has become extremely important in literary studies, particularly in women's studies. Born in Wondelgem, Belgium, Miss Sarton came to the United States in 1916 at the age of four. She and her parents, all refugees of World War I, settled in Cambridge, MA. Becoming involved with the theater at the age of 17, Miss Sarton held various directorships and founded the Apprentice Theatre in 1933. Her efforts turned to teaching in 1937 when she began to teach creative writing at the Stuart School in Boston. In 1940, in addition to her writing, she began to lecture on poetry at various colleges, and would continue to do so for the next 45 years. Miss Sarton has also served as a poet-in-residence at Southern Illinois University; as a Briggs-Copeland Instructor at Harvard University; as a creative writing lecturer at Wellesley College; and most recently as a writer-in-residence at Colby College, among other positions. A Fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences since 1958, Miss Sarton is an honorary member of Phi Beta Kappa at Radcliffe College, and is the recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship and a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts. The recipient of more than a dozen honorary doctorates, Miss Sarton has also received the Golden Rose Award (1945) from the New England Poetry Society, the Human Rights Award (1985), the Fund for Human Dignity Award (1984), and the Avon/COCOA Pioneer Woman Award (1983), among others. She makes her home in York, Maine.
