Firm our advance, naught can us e'er beguile.



# HELEN M. ALVARÉ, ESQ. Doctor of Sacred Theology

elen M. Alvaré, Esq. is the director of planning and information and secretariat for pro-life activities at the National Conference of Catholic Bishops. As such, she is the national spokesperson for the NCCB on the abortion issue. Alvaré also manages the NCCB's contracts with outside communications consultants, and has financial, programming, and policy responsibilities. Alvaré has appeared on behalf of the NCCB on television news programs such as "Firing Line," "NewsHour with Jim Lehrer," "This Week with David Brinkley," "Charlie Rose," "Crossfire," "Good Morning America," "Today," and many other programs. She writes columns for the Catholic press and op-ed articles for secular newspapers. Her statements on behalf of the bishops are cited regularly in major news magazines and newspapers. She also testifies on behalf of the bishops before federal congressional committees and before the platform committees of the Democratic and Republican parties. In 1994, Time magazine named Alvaré one of the top 50 leaders in America under age 40. Prior to assuming her position with the NCCB in 1990, Alvaré served for three years as an attorney in the Office of the General Counsel for the United States Catholic Conference, the public policy arm of the NCCB. There, she co-authored amicus briefs entered by the USCC in the Supreme Court in major abortion cases, as well as cases addressing euthanasia and the First Amendment. A summa cum laude graduate of Villanova University in 1981, Alvaré received her law degree from Cornell University in 1984. In 1989, she completed her master of arts degree in theology at the Catholic University of America. She studied theology for two additional years at Catholic University before leaving the doctoral program to assume her current position.






# MARY HIGGINS CLARK Doctor of Humane Letters

ary Higgins Clark is the author of 15 worldwide best-sellers: Where Are the Children? (1975); A Stranger is Watching (1978); The Cradle Will Fall (1980); A Cry in the Night (1982); Stillwatch (1984); Weep No More, My Lady (1987); While My Pretty One Sleeps (1989); The Anastasia Syndrome & Other Stories (1989); Loves Music, Loves to Dance (1991); All Around the Town (1992); I'll Be Seeing You (1993); Remember Me (1994); The Lottery Winner: Alvirah & Willy Stories (1994); Let Me Call You Sweetheart (1995); and Silent Night (1995), all published in hardcover by Simon & Schuster and in paperback by Pocket Books. Clark's latest novel, Moonlight Becomes You, has just been published by Simon & Schuster and has been simultaneously released by Simon & Schuster Audio. Many of her novels have been adapted into feature-length films and television movies. Upon graduating from high school, the New York City native attended secretarial school, worked for an advertising agency, and as a stewardess for Pan American Airlines. She married a neighbor, Warren Clark, and began writing short stories; she sold her first story to Extension Magazine in 1956 for \$100. Left a young widow with five children when her husband died in 1964, she began writing radio scripts and decided to try her hand at novels. Clark considers her Irish heritage a strong influence on her writing. Her first suspense novel, Where Are the Children?, became a best-seller. In 1974, Clark entered Fordham University and graduated summa cum laude in 1979 with a bachelor of arts degree in philosophy. She is a trustee of Fordham University, a member of the Board of Regents of St. Peter's College, and an active advocate and participant in literacy programs. She has 12 honorary doctorates. Clark served as chairman of the International Crime Congress held in New York in May 1988, and for many years, was a member of the Board of Directors of the Mystery Writers of America, serving as president in 1987. She received the Grand Prix de Literature of France in 1980.






# LAWRENCE KINGSBAKER FISH Doctor of Business Administration

awrence Kingsbaker Fish is chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Citizens Financial Group, Inc., a multi-state bank holding company headquartered in Providence, R.I. Under his leadership, Citizens has more than doubled its size in three years to become the fourth-largest commercial banking company in New England and one of the 60 largest in the U.S. He is a director of John Hancock Financial Services and the Royal Bank of Scotland. He is a trustee of Rhode Island School of Design, Beth Israel Hospital, and the National Conference. He cochairs the state Economic Development Council with Rhode Island Governor Lincoln Almond, and is also chairman of the Rhode Island Commission for National and Community Service. The banking leader is a trustee and board member of the New England Conservatory of Music, trustee of the MacDowell Colony, Inc., and an overseer of the Isabella Stewart Gardner Museum. He is past chairman of the Governor's International Trade Advisory Board for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. He is a trustee and board member of Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa. A 1966 honors graduate of Drake, Fish earned an MBA from the Harvard Graduate School of Business Administration in 1968. He was the recipient of Harvard's Frank Knox Fellowship, which included graduate study at the London School of Economics and study in India. He holds two honorary degrees. Fish's banking career began in 1972 at Bank of Boston, where he worked in various senior positions in Brazil, Japan, Hong Kong, and Boston. In 1988, Fish joined the bank's board of directors and was named executive vice president and group executive in charge of all New England banking. Prior to joining Citizens in April 1992, Fish, as chairman and CEO of the Boston-based Bank of New England Corp., led the fight to revive the ailing company. While deterioration of the New England economy and the company's troubled \$8 billion real estate portfolio required FDIC intervention in 1991, Fish's efforts were praised by regulators and analysts.






# Dr. Joseph H. Hagan Doctor of Public Service

r. Joseph H. Hagan has served as president of Assumption College in Worcester, Mass. since 1978. He is also a lecturer in politics and a member of that institution's board of trustees. A Providence, R.I. native, Hagan graduated with honors from Providence College in 1956. He attended Boston University, where he received his master's degree, and the Harvard University Institute of Educational Management. He received his doctoral degree from the Graduate Theological Foundation. Hagan holds an honorary master of business administration degree and three honorary doctorates. A Providence College trustee since 1994, Hagan received the alumni association's Award for Distinguished Service to Education in 1986 and was a recipient of the college's Diamond Jubilee Award in 1992. He has a distinguished history of service to the church. Hagan was promoted in 1994 to the rank of Knight of Grace and Devotion of the Order of Malta by His Most Eminent Highness Frá Andrew Bertie, Prince and Grand Master of the Order. Last year, he became the first Knight of Obedience in the American Association of the Order of Malta. Pope John Paul II promoted him to the rank of Papal Knight of the Grand Cross of the Order of Saint Gregory the Great in 1994. He was named a Gentleman-in-Waiting to Pope John Paul II in 1991 and, in 1995, was named to a five-year term as a consultor to the Pontifical Council on the Family. In 1994, Hagan was named a Knight Jure Sanguinis of the Sacred Military Constantinian Order of Saint George by His Royal Highness Prince Don Carlos de Bourbon, Grand Master of the Order, and, in 1995, was promoted to the rank of Knight Grand Cross Jure Sanguinas. Hagan received the Catholic Brotherhood Award from the Worcester Chapter of the National Conference in 1993 and the d'Alzon Medal, the highest award conferred by the Augustinians of the Assumption, in 1995. In 1992, President Bush named him to the National Council on the Humanities. He is vice chairman of the John Cabot University (Rome, Italy) Board of Trustees.





# LIEUTENANT GENERAL (USA, RET.) VERNON A. WALTERS Doctor of Public Administration

ieutenant General (USA, Ret.) Vernon A. Walters, former U.S. ambassador to the United Nations and to the Federal Republic of Germany, served on active duty in the United States Army for 36 years. Born in New York City, he was educated in Europe at St. Louis Gonzaga in Paris and Stonyhurst College in England. He enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1941 as a private and rose through the ranks, retiring at the rank of lieutenant general in 1976. He was present at many world events that determined the course of modern history. General Walters served in North Africa and Italy during World War II. He also served during the Korean Conflict and the Vietnam War. Conversant in eight languages, he was an aide and interpreter to Presidents Roosevelt, Truman, Eisenhower, Johnson, and Nixon, and to Generals Marshall and Bradley. After World War II, he served as military attaché to Italy, Brazil, and France. In 1972, General Walters was appointed deputy director of Central Intelligence by President Nixon, and was unanimously confirmed by the Senate. He retired from that post in 1976. Recalled to government service three years later, General Walters served as ambassador-at-large and, from 1985-89, served as ambassador to the United Nations and a member of President Reagan's Cabinet. In 1989, President George Bush appointed him as ambassador to the Federal Republic of Germany, where he witnessed the fall of the Berlin Wall and the political reunification of Germany. General Walters is the recipient of numerous U.S. and foreign medals, including the Presidential Medal of Freedom, the National Security Medal, the Presidential Medal for Citizens, three Distinguished Service Medals, two Legions of Merit, the Bronze Star, and the Air Medal. He has received 23 honorary degrees. General Walters has written a number of books; Silent Missions, The Wall Falls, Cat from Ipanema, The Mighty and the Meek, and the novel Sunset at Saigon. He is currently at work on two other books.
