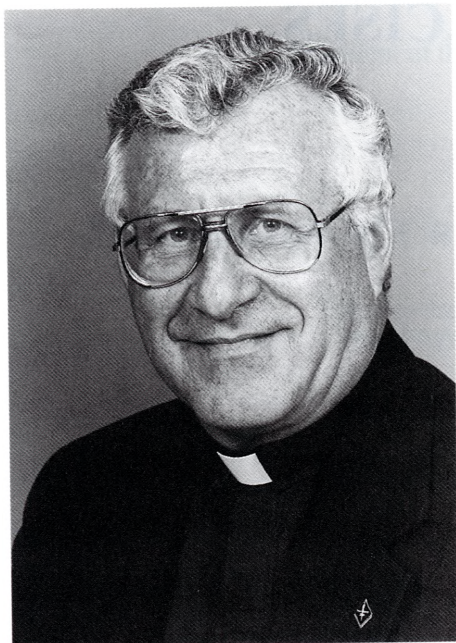

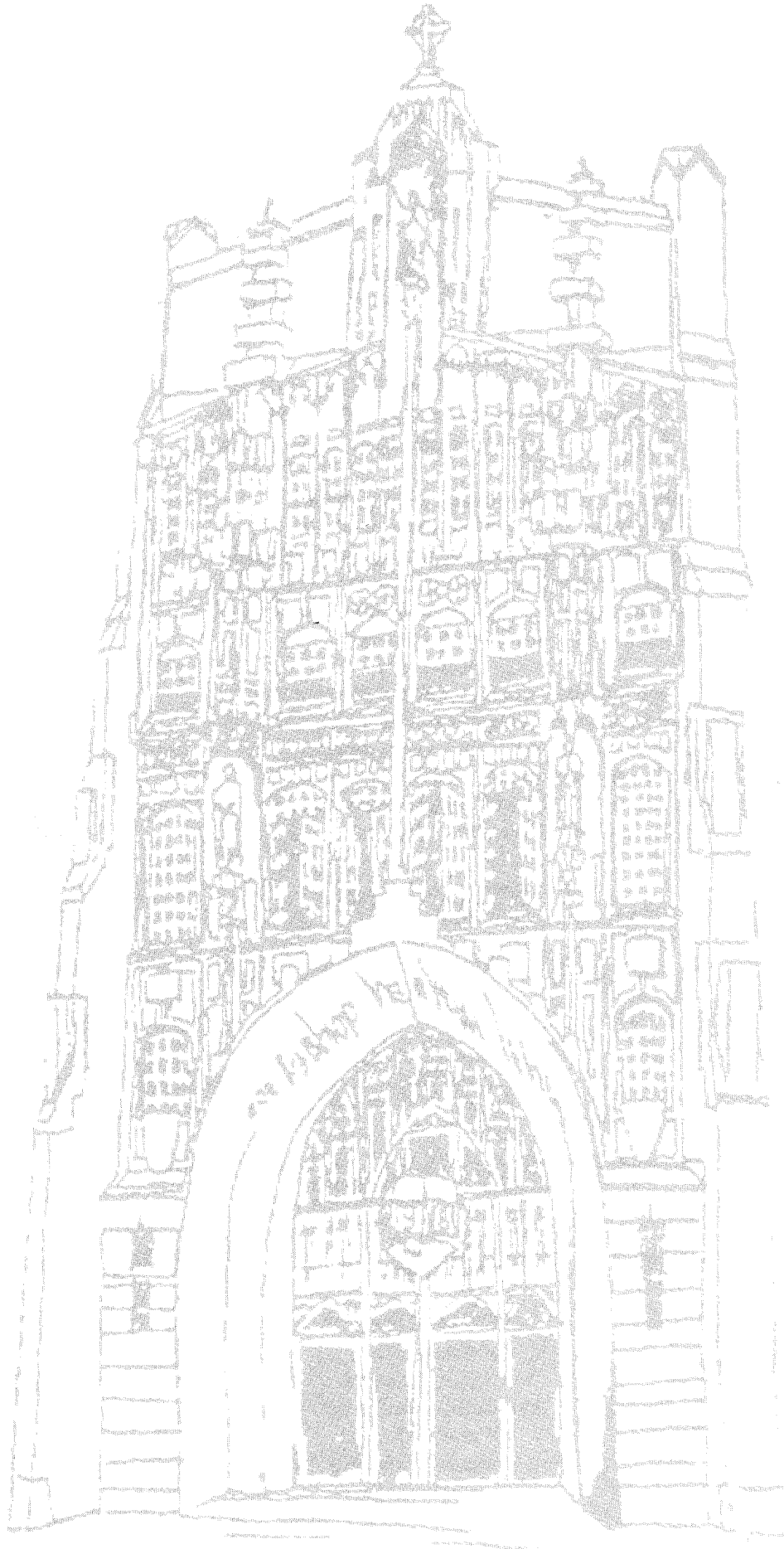

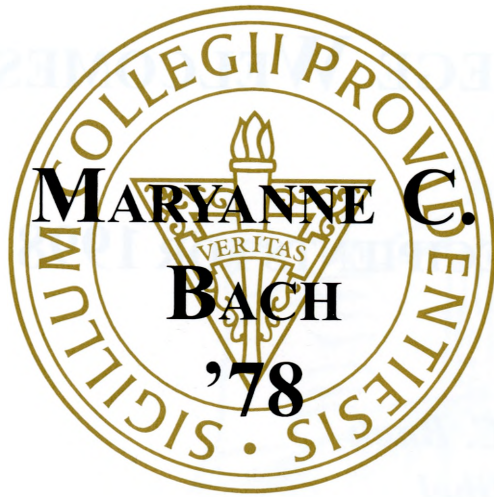

Maryanne C. Bach '78 is assistant director of the Program Analysis Office of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, Department of the Interior. The highest-ranking female graduate of Providence College within the federal government, Bach earlier served as deputy regional director of the Bureau's Great Plains Region, overseeing a staff of approximately 750 employees in a nine-state area west of the Mississippi River stretching from the Canadian border to the southern tip of Texas. The Bureau's projects provide irrigation water to nearly three million acres of farmland, and serve a rural, urban, and Native American population of more than three million.

Prior to accepting this post, Bach served in the corporate office of the U.S. Department of the Interior as director of program analysis and special assistant to the secretary for policy. She held a special assignment as assistant director responsible for the Federal Coordinating Council for Science, Engineering, and Technology. In this position, Bach reported directly to the assistant to the President for science and technology and director of the White House Office of Science and Technology Policy. Earlier, she served as deputy assistant secretary for Fish, Wildlife and Parks, managing the department's multimillion dollar portfolio for the National Park Service and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services.

A widely respected authority on environmental and science issues, Bach has served in numerous prestigious legislative and administrative positions promoting the advancement of science and overseeing science policy. She served eight years on the staff of the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology of the U.S. House of Representatives, overseeing and coordinating major policy on research and development activities and environmental programs for agencies such as the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, the Environmental Protection Agency, the Department of Energy, and the National Science Foundation, among others.

Bach earned a B.S. (cum laude) in biology from PC and a M.S. in botany and plant ecology (magna cum laude) from Iowa State University. She is a member of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, Phi Sigma Tau, Phi Kappa Phi, the Iowa Academy of Science, and The Nature Conservancy.

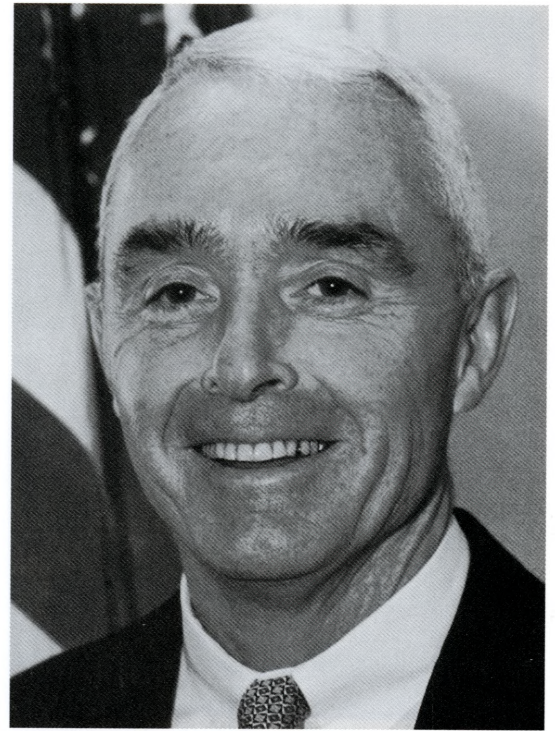


Edna Hibel, world-renowned artist and curator and trustee of the Hibel Museum of Art in Palm Beach, Florida, has exhibited her artwork in galleries and museums in twenty countries on four continents. A native of Brookline, Mass., she became the youngest artist honored by a major American museum when the Boston Museum of Fine Arts purchased one of her paintings for its permanent collection in 1940.

Since this auspicious start to her artistic career, Hibel's laurels have included one-artist shows at London's Guggenheim Gallery and The Mall Galleries, and at the Museu Nacional De Belas Artes in Rio de Janeiro. Her artwork has also been exhibited in museums, galleries, universities, and palaces in countries throughout the world, including Austria, Belgium, Costa Rica, Israel, and Japan, as well as the United States.

Prolific in a variety of media, Hibel has received a number of international accolades, including Medals of Honor from Pope John Paul II and from the late Belgian King Baudouin. She is also the first foreign woman artist to exhibit in the People's Republic of China, the former Yugoslavia, and the former Soviet Union. Known for her sensitive portrayals of mothers and children of all cultures, her style has been compared to that of Italian Renaissance artist Leonardo da Vinci and to American Impressionist Mary Cassatt.

A graduate of the Boston Museum School of Fine Arts in painting, Hibel holds honorary degrees from the University for Peace in Costa Rica; Mt. St. Mary's College in Maryland; Eureka College in Illinois; and Flanders Academy of Art, Science, and Letters in Belgium. She and her husband, writer Theodore Plotkin, have three children and five grandchildren.

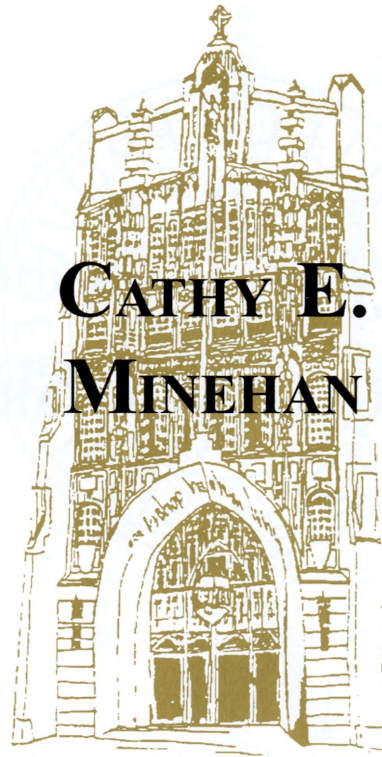


General Barry R. McCaffrey (USA, Ret.) is director of the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, serving as a full member of the President's Cabinet and as the senior drug policy official in the Executive Branch. As President Clinton's chief drug policy spokesman since 1996, he is also a member of the National Security Council and the president's Drug Policy Council.

General McCaffrey's prior experience prepared him well for the role of drug czar. Before his confirmation, he served as commander in chief of the U. S. Armed Forces Southern Command, coordinating U.S. international security policy with foreign heads of government, ministers of defense, and U.S. ambassadors in nineteen Central and South American countries.

As principal staff assistant to General Colin Powell, former chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, General McCaffrey acted as the chairman's liaison to the National Security Council and served as military advisor to Presidents Bush and Clinton and to then-U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations Madeleine Albright.

A graduate of the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, General McCaffrey was the most highly decorated combat officer and youngest Army four-star general at his retirement. General McCaffrey and his wife, Jill (national chairman for the Armed Forces Emergency Services for the American Red Cross) have three married children, one an Army infantry major, one a National Guard captain, and one a teacher.

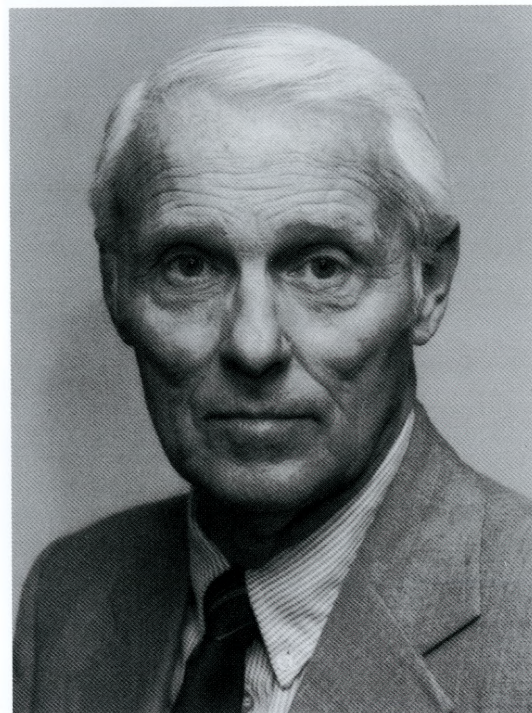


Cathy E. Minehan is president and chief executive officer of the Federal Reserve Bank of Boston, one of twelve regional reserve banks that together with the Board of Governors in Washington, D.C. form the Federal Reserve System. A 30-year veteran of the Federal Reserve system, Minehan became the first woman to hold this post when she was named president of the Boston Fed in July 1994.

Minehan's primary responsibility as one of the nation's central bankers is contributing to policy decisions that promote the safety and soundness of the U.S. financial system, as well as the health of the country's economy. In this role she has focused her energies on areas of structural economic development in New England, including community development, public education, and training. She is currently chair of the Financial Services Policy Committee for the Federal Reserve System, overseeing activities of the banks' five product and function offices as well as its automation support operation.

From 1991-94, Minehan served as first vice president and chief operating officer of the Boston Fed. Her career with the Federal Reserve System began as a bank examiner straight out of the University of Rochester in 1968 and continued through a series of vice presidential posts.

Minehan holds an MBA from New York University and was named a 1995 Distinguished Alumna of NYU. She has also received several leadership awards, including the New England Women's Leadership Award and the International Women's Forum "Women That Make a Difference Award." Minehan holds honorary degrees from the University of Massachusetts at Boston, the College of the Holy Cross, Stonehill College, and Bentley College.



Joseph A. Mullaney, Sr., head coach of the basketball Friars from 1955-1969, guided the Friars to three NCAA berths and six NITs. It was under his leadership that Providence College gained the national spotlight for the success of its basketball program, beginning with a major upset against nationally known powerhouse Notre Dame. His teams captured the NIT Championship title in both 1961 and 1963.

The Holy Cross graduate recorded nine consecutive 20-win seasons, following each with post-season tournaments. Mullaney garnered the National Coach of the Year Award in 1961, along with New England Coach of the Year honors in 1964, 1965, and 1966.

Following his PC tenure, Mullaney coached professional basketball for eight years, bringing three different teams to World Championship finals, the Los Angeles Lakers, the Kentucky Colonels, and the Utah Stars. He was the 1974 ABA Coach of the Year. He coached in Italy for one year before returning to Providence to serve as head coach at Brown University, where he earned New England Coach of the Year honors in 1980. The following year he returned to PC, where he coached for four seasons and served as associate director of athletics until August of 1988, when he accepted a head coaching position with Pensacola of the CBA. Now retired and living in North Providence, RI, Mullaney and his wife, Jane, are the parents of four sons and one daughter.



CARDINAL JAIME LUCAS ORTEGA Y ALAMINO



His Eminence Cardinal Jaime Lucas Ortega y Alamino is the Archbishop of San Cristobal de La Habana, Cuba. The son of a sugar cane cutter, he has worked to keep the Cuban church alive among that country's 4.5 million Roman Catholics in the face of the relentless atheism of the Castro regime. The priest, who was detained for ten months in 1966 in a prison camp as an "enemy of the Cuban revolution," earlier this year won permission from Fidel Castro to give a speech on Cuban television, the first such address by a religious leader since the revolution.

Cardinal Ortega, who taught philosophy classes at Havana Seminary in the 1970s, was elevated to Bishop of Pinar Del Rio diocese in 1978 and named archbishop of Havana by John Paul II in 1981. He was elevated to cardinal in 1994, Cuba's first in more than three decades.

Under Cardinal Ortega's leadership the Cuban catechism has been rewritten in simpler language, two new dioceses were created, and the church has used neighborhood parishes to provide aid to the poor, including food and medicine. The cardinal has encouraged local churches to sponsor adult night schools and to host Bible study and prayer groups, providing a safe haven for many Cubans to gather free from government surveillance.

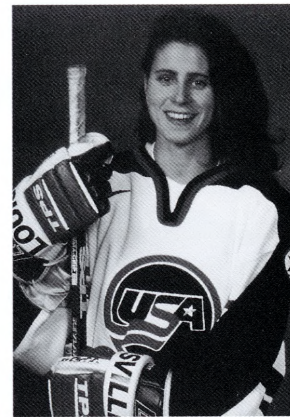
Most significantly, in addition to hosting John Paul II's 1998 visit to his island nation, Cardinal Ortega has called upon Castro to begin a national dialogue of national reconciliation among all Cubans, including the exile communities of Florida, Puerto Rico, Mexico, and Spain.

Providence College is extremely proud of the seven Lady Friars who helped propel the Team USA Women's Hockey win at the 1998 Olympic games in Nagano, Japan.

Defenseman Bailey (#24) is a four-time member of the U.S. Women's National Team and former PC Rookie of the Year (1990-91), all-Eastern College Athletic Conference honoree and Most Valuable Player at the 1994 ECAC Championship Tournament.

Forward Baker (#8) made her first appearance on a U.S. Women's National Team in 1997. Just completing her sophomore year at Providence, Baker finished the 1996-97 Friars season second in ECAC scoring and was named 1995-96 ECAC Rookie of the Year.

Forward Blahoski (#18) has been selected twice for the U.S. Women's National Team and as Friars co-captain during her senior year was named the 1995-96 ECAC Co-Player of the Year and earned ECAC All-Tournament honors in 1995.



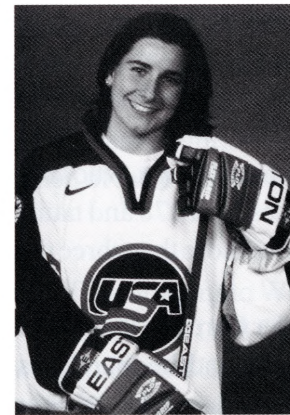

Forward Brown-Miller (#3) is one of only three players to have appeared on all six teams since the U.S. squad's inception in 1990. She was named Most Valuable Player of the 1992 U. S. Women's National Team and ECAC Player of the Year for the 1987-88 season.

Goaltender DeCosta (#1) first appeared on a U.S. Women's National Team at the 1996 IIHF Pacific Women's Hockey Championship. At the end of her 1996-97 freshman season at PC, Baker posted an 18-7-2 record, with 2.66 goals against average and received an ECAC honorable mention.

Forward Granato (#21), also a six-time member of the U.S. Women's National Team, is the all-time leading scorer in the history of the team. One of the most-recognized U.S. women's hockey players, Granato helped lead the Friars to consecutive ECAC Championships in 1991-92 and 1992-93.

Defenseman Movsessian (#14) is a four-time member of the U.S. Women's National Team. During her Providence career, Movsessian earned ECAC second-team honors, was named to the New England Hockey Writers All-Star Team, and in 1994 was named All-America Scholar-Athlete.
