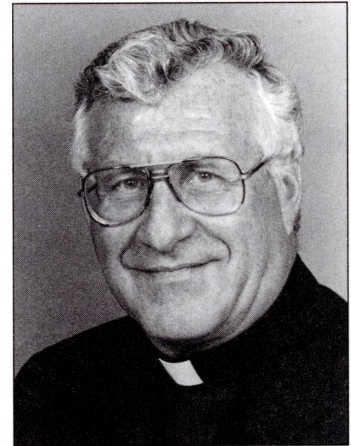
FROM THE PRESIDENT

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENTS

DR. LISA SOWLE CAHILL

*J. Donald Monan, S.J.,
Professor of Theology
Boston College*



Dr. Lisa Sowle Cahill is the J. Donald Monan, S.J., Professor of Theology at Boston College in Chestnut Hill, Mass., where she has been a member of the faculty since 1976. After receiving her B.A. in theology from Santa Clara University in 1970, Cahill earned her M.A. and Ph.D. degrees at the University of Chicago Divinity School.

Cahill is at the forefront of theological scholarship, with special interests in the use of scripture in ethics, the ethics of sex and gender, medical ethics, and the history of Christian ethics. She is a past president of both the Catholic Theological Society of America and the Society of Christian Ethics. In 1986, she was a visiting scholar at the Kennedy Institute of Ethics at Georgetown University and in 1997, she was a visiting professor of Catholic theology at Yale University.

Cahill has served in numerous advisory capacities to bishops, committees, and conferences. She has been a member of the Catholic Health Association Theology and Ethics Advisory Committee and The National Advisory Board for Ethics in Reproduction, and serves on the March of Dimes National Bioethics Committee. In February 1998, Cahill delivered a paper on "Women's Health and Human Flourishing" at a Vatican conference on "Women's Health Issues" conducted under the aegis of the Pontifical Academy of Life. She was also an invited participant in the first "Cardinal Bernardin Conference" of the Catholic Common Ground Initiative in 1997.

A fellow of the American Academy of Arts and Sciences, Cahill has authored or coauthored several books, including *Sex, Gender, and Christian Ethics* (Cambridge University Press, 1996); *Love Your Enemies: Discipleship, Pacifism, and Just War Theory* (Fortress, 1994); and *Between the Sexes: Toward a Christian Ethics of Sexuality* (Fortress and Paulist Presses, 1985). She has also authored over 100 scholarly essays in books and journals and, in 1984, became the first non-Jesuit to serve as contributor to the "Moral Notes," *Theological Studies'* annual bibliographical essay on moral theology.

The recipient of honorary degrees from numerous institutions of higher education, Cahill resides in Chestnut Hill, Mass. with her husband of 27 years, Lawrence R. Cahill, an attorney, and her children: Charlotte, 20; James, 16; Donald, 15; William, 15; and Gregory, 13.

Charlotte G. Gragnani of West Hyattsville, Maryland, a devoted benefactor of Providence College, attributes all her goodness to the loving upbringing her parents provided her. She attended public schools in Maryland and Washington, D.C., graduated from the business high school in Washington, D.C., and later took courses at Maryland Community College. Following her high school graduation, she went to work as a medical secretary at Walter Reed Army Hospital. She eventually resigned this position to care for her mother, who was ill with cancer.

After her mother's death, Mrs. Gragnani served as a civilian worker for the Pentagon for the Department of the Army in Japan. While attending a Christmas party at the Australian Officers' Club in Tokyo in 1952, she met Francis "Frank" L. Gragnani, a 1940 graduate of Providence College. They were married on January 23, 1954 back in the United States.

The Gragnanis later returned to Japan, where Frank acquired a franchise from the Coca-Cola Company for two bottling plants in Nagano. During this time, Mrs. Gragnani learned Japanese flower arranging, took oil painting lessons, taught English to Japanese nurses at the Seventh Day Adventist Hospital, and served as a Gray Lady with the American Red Cross.

Mr. Gragnani eventually sold his bottling plants to the Coca-Cola Export Corporation and returned to the United States, where he founded the Winthrop Finance Corporation of Boston. He would later serve as director emeritus of the corporation.

In 1989, Frank was diagnosed with cancer and treated at The Vincent Lombardi Cancer Center at the Georgetown University Medical Center. After his death, Mrs. Gragnani, who had lost several family members to the disease, endowed the Director's Chair of the Lombardi Cancer Center in the name of Francis L. and Charlotte G. Gragnani.

Over the years, Frank's great love for Providence College led him to contribute generously to the school's advancement. In 1983, the Gragnanis made the lead gift toward construction of the college's Dominican Priory. Mrs. Gragnani has continued this legacy, most recently contributing the seed money for a new chapel for the Providence College community.

CHARLES DESSOW HINCE '92

*Vice President, National Spinal
Cord Injury Association,
Boston Chapter*



Charles "Charlie" Hince, a resident of Milford, Mass., is a 1992 graduate of Providence College who earned his bachelor of science degree in marketing. The BIG EAST All-Academic Swimmer was paralyzed from the shoulders down as the result of a swimming accident in August 1996. While bodysurfing with friends on Martha's Vineyard in August 1996, a wave flipped him head-first into the ocean floor. The impact broke his neck and he spent the next 20 days breathing through a ventilator.

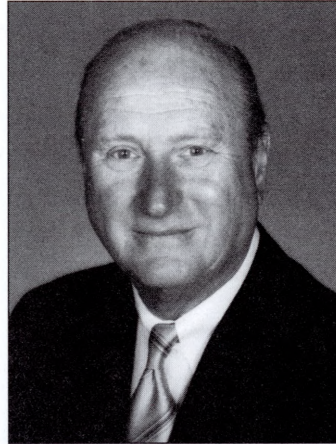
As a result of his injuries, Hince is paralyzed from the shoulders down. Despite undergoing the rigors of full-time rehabilitation, his drive and determination have remained high, garnering him national attention for his efforts.

On May 7, 1997, Hince was featured in a special edition of CBS's *48 Hours*, anchored by Dan Rather, that focused on spinal cord injuries. He was nationally recognized for his determination to move on, despite the daily challenges of his paralysis. The program also included an interview with actor Christopher Reeve, himself a victim of a severe spinal cord injury. The two met shortly thereafter.

Hince's injuries have not prevented him from taking on a full complement of community activities and social activism. He is a board member of the National Spinal Cord Injury Association, and a board member, peer visitor, prevention awareness coordinator, and vice president of the association's Boston Chapter. He is a member of the Consumer Advisory Board of the New England Spinal Cord Injury Center at Boston Medical Center and lectures on physical therapy at the Spinal Cord Unit of the Boston Medical Center, Boston University, and Quinsigamund Community College. He also presents educational awareness lectures at Bridgewater State College.

Hince's perseverance continues to be a source of inspiration for all who know him. On April 24, 1999, Providence College swimmers gathered at the college's Taylor Pool for the Hince Swim-a-thon, held to benefit Hince's ongoing rehabilitation equipment costs not covered by his insurance.

Frederick C. Lohrum, a native of Cincinnati, Ohio, is south region chairman and chief executive officer of BankBoston, N.A., a wholly-owned subsidiary of BankBoston Corporation. A veteran of the United States Navy, Lohrum has distinguished himself as a professional in the business community and as a leading citizen in community affairs.

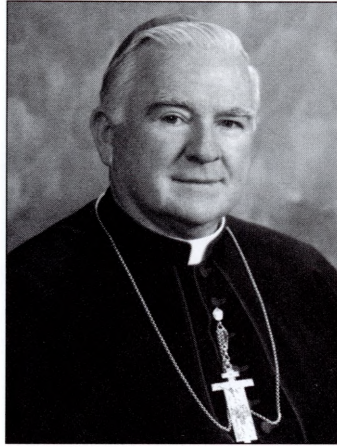
After earning a B.S. degree in industrial management from the University of Cincinnati in 1952, Lohrum joined the United States Navy. He attained the rank of lieutenant and served as an operations officer aboard the destroyer USS Rooks, based in Newport, R.I. He began his business career with IBM after leaving the military in 1955. In 1968, he joined Randolph Computer Corporation, a lessor of IBM computer equipment, which was purchased by Bank of Boston Corporation in 1972. He served in several executive positions, including chairman and president of BancBoston Leasing, Inc., BancBoston Leasing Services, and Randolph Computer Services. Under his stewardship, BancBoston Leasing became the fourth-largest bank lessor in the nation. Lohrum later was named chairman, president, and chief executive officer of Bank of Boston Connecticut. In 1992, he was elected chairman and chief executive officer of Rhode Island Hospital Trust. He was appointed to his present BankBoston position in 1998.

Lohrum is involved in a number of professional, educational, and civic organizations and has received a number of prestigious awards for his community service. A member of the President's Council of Providence College, he is also a member of the boards of Salve Regina University, Rhode Island School of Design, and Bryant College. He is a trustee of the URI Foundation and a Life Foundation member of the Naval War College. Lohrum serves as chairman-elect of the Greater Providence Chamber of Commerce, chairman of the Board of Directors of the United Way of Southeastern New England, and a board member of the Rhode Island Public Expenditures Council. He is an honorary trustee of Rhode Island Hospital, a board member of Hospice Care of Rhode Island, and chairman of the board for Business Volunteers for the Arts/RI.

He resides in Middletown, R.I. with his wife, Phyllis Dayton Lohrum. They are the parents of three grown children, Kristin, Alison, and Fred, Jr.

THE MOST REVEREND
ROBERT E. MULVEE

Bishop of Providence



The Most Reverend Robert Edward Mulvee, Bishop of Providence, has led a distinguished career in the church. A native of Boston, Mass., he studied for the priesthood at St. Thomas Seminary in Bloomfield, Conn.; St. Paul Seminary at the University of Ottawa, Canada; and the American College at the University of Louvain in Belgium. In 1964, Bishop Mulvee received a master's degree in religious education from the University of Louvain and a doctorate in Canon Law from the Pontifical Lateran University in Rome. He was ordained to the priesthood for the Diocese of Manchester on June 30, 1957, at Louvain.

Following ordination, Bishop Mulvee served a number of New Hampshire parishes. In 1964, he was appointed assistant chancellor of the Diocese of Manchester. In October 1966, Pope Paul VI made him a papal chamberlain, with the title of monsignor. He was named a prelate of honor in 1970 and in April 1972, he was named chancellor of the Diocese of Manchester.

In February of 1977, he was named as the first Auxiliary Bishop of Manchester and was ordained to the episcopacy in April of that year. Appointed the seventh Bishop of Wilmington in 1985, he was named Coadjutor Bishop of Providence in 1995 and became the seventh Bishop of Providence on June 11, 1997.

Bishop Mulvee has served on many national and regional boards and committees. He was a member of the Bishops' National Advisory Council from 1978 to 1982. For eight years he served on the Board of Bishops for the American College of Louvain and was named its chairman in 1986. He was vice-chairman and chairman of the New England Council of Church Leaders and the Ecumenical Council of Christian Denominational Executives in New England.

Bishop Mulvee also serves on the boards of trustees of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C., The Catholic University of America, and the Pope John XXIII National Seminary in Boston. He has been a member of the Roman Catholic/Orthodox Dialogue since 1984. As Bishop of Providence, he serves on numerous corporations and boards throughout the diocese, including St. Joseph Health Services, Salve Regina University, and Providence College.

Timothy J. Russert is a broadcast journalist best known as the moderator of NBC's *Meet the Press*, the longest-running program in the history of television. Since Russert took the helm of *Meet the Press* in December 1991, the program has become the most watched Sunday morning interview show in America and the most quoted news program in the world. As host, Russert has interviewed every major American political figure.

A political analyst for *NBC Nightly News* and the *Today* program, Russert also anchors *The Tim Russert Show*, a weekly CNBC program that examines the role of the media in American society. In addition, he is a contributing anchor for MSNBC Cable as well as senior vice president and Washington bureau chief of NBC News. On PBS, Russert hosts the *Fred Friendly Seminars*, a public television series that explores complex vital issues.

Russert joined NBC News in 1984, after serving as a special counsel to the U.S. Senate and as counselor in the New York governor's office in Albany, positions that allowed him to observe the inner workings of government firsthand. Since joining NBC, he has supervised live broadcasts from Rome, arranging for the first appearance of Pope John Paul II on American television; led week-long broadcasts from South America, Australia, and China; and oversaw prime time news specials, "A Day in the Life of President Bush," (1990) and "A Day in the Life of President Clinton" (1993). He has also covered eight U.S.-Russia summit meetings.

Russert holds a bachelor of arts degree in political science from John Carroll University and a juris doctor degree from the Cleveland Marshall College of Law. He is the recipient of 12 honorary degrees and has lectured at more than 30 schools around the country. He is a trustee of the Freedom Forum's *Newseum* and a member of the boards of directors of the Greater Washington Boys and Girls Club and of America's Promise, The Alliance for Youth. Russert is the recipient of numerous accolades, including the National Catholic Education Association's Distinguished Graduate Award. *Irish America* magazine named him one of the top 100 Irish-Americans in the country.

Named *Parents* magazine's "Dream Dad" in 1998, Russert resides in Washington, D.C. with his wife, *Vanity Fair* magazine writer Maureen Orth, and his son, Luke, 13.
